Report: The Department of Business Administration and students of BBA of Regular & Aviation, St Francis de Sales College, conducted Outreach program on 17th November 2023 at Moulana Azad School, Electronic City with 116 student volunteers. The objective of the program is to raise awareness

The day commenced with an engaging session on basic mathematics and language skills. Dividing the students into groups, interactive games and exercises were organized, fostering a collaborative learning environment. The joy on the faces of both the BBA students and the school children illuminated the classrooms as they tackled problems together, making learning an enjoyable experience.
