### **The objective of the Program:**

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Cultural Exchange and Social Integration: Encouraging interaction between students from diverse backgrounds, the program aimed to promote cultural exchange and social integration. Breaking barriers and stereotypes, it aimed to foster a sense of understanding, empathy, and camaraderie among participants.

**Report:** The Department of Business Administration and students of BBA of Regular & Aviation, St Francis de Sales College, conducted Outreach program on 17th November 2023 at Moulana Azad School, Electronic City with 116 student volunteers. The objective of the program is to raise awareness

The day commenced with an engaging session on basic mathematics and language skills. Dividing the students into groups, interactive games and exercises were organized, fostering a collaborative learning environment. The joy on the faces of both the BBA students and the school children illuminated the classrooms as they tackled problems together, making learning an enjoyable experience.

A highlight of the program was the motivational speeches delivered by our students, sharing their personal journeys and emphasizing the importance of education in shaping their lives. Witnessing the school children's eagerness to learn and absorb new knowledge was truly inspiring.

The BBA students also conducted a workshop on creative thinking and problem-solving techniques. **Motivational Speech:** The motivational speech segment aimed to inspire and motivate the students by sharing success stories, personal journeys, and emphasizing the importance of determination, hard work, and education in achieving goals.



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**Course Guidance Session:** This session provided insights into various career paths, educational opportunities, and guidance on choosing suitable courses. It aimed to broaden the students' horizons and help them make informed decisions about their future.

**National Leaders Session:** Focused on educating students about the lives and contributions of national leaders, this session aimed to instill values of leadership, patriotism, and social responsibility among the young minds.
