### Report:

On 17<sup>th</sup> January, 2024, the School of Business and Management organized a social outreach activity to Sipani Seva Sadan, an NGO, as part of our ongoing commitment to community service. Mrs. Ashwini, Ms. Suma and Mrs Keerthi accompanied the students (I BBA & II BBA) to the place of visit.

Sipani Seva Sadan is an NGO serving 400 destitute patients (age group of 18 to 90 years) with shelter and care, with general medical facilities free of cost. It is an Old-age Home cum Orphanage which also provides a FREE ambulance service and picks up people from the streets. They give them shelter, food, clothing, medical support and help them get back on their feet.

The purpose of the visit was to interact with the patients and residents, bring joy to their lives, and gain a better understanding of the challenges faced by the elderly and unprivileged population. Students generously contributed for the groceries we donated to NGO.

**Objectives:**

1. To engage in meaningful interactions with the elderly residents and unprivileged people and offer companionship.
2. To contribute to the emotional well-being of the residents by organizing recreational activities.
3. To observe and understand the living conditions and needs of the people in the old-age home cum orphanage.

Upon arrival at the Sipani Seva Sadan, the faculty and students were warmly welcomed by the staff and residents. The visit commenced with a brief orientation about the facility and an introduction to some of the residents. The following activities were organized during the visit:

1. Interactive Sessions: The students engaged themselves in one-on-one conversations with the elderly residents, listening to their life stories, experiences, and providing them with companionship. This allowed the residents to feel valued and heard, and it provided our team with valuable insights into their lives.
2. Recreational Activities: A variety of recreational activities, such as games, music and dance were organized to uplift the spirits of the elderly residents. These activities created an atmosphere of joy and laughter, fostering a sense of community and shared experiences.
3. Distribution of Essential Items – Groceries and Snacks: The students also distributed snacks to all the residents of the NGO at the time of conducting recreational activities. To serve the purpose of the visit the students donated Groceries worth Rs. 22500 which included rice bags, oil, wheat, snacks, etc.,

A few students donated clothes, blankets and bedspreads as a gesture of care for the inmates.

**Observations:**

Through our interactions and observations, we gained a deeper understanding of the challenges faced by the elderly residents. Many of them expressed feelings of loneliness and a desire for more social interaction. Additionally, we noted the need for improved facilities and resources within the old-age home to enhance the residents' overall well-being.

**Outcome of the Visit:**

The visit had a positive impact on both the residents and the department members – students and faculty. The elderly residents expressed their gratitude for the companionship and attention, while our students found the experience to be enriching and humbling.

Following this visit, the School of Business & Management aims to continue its engagement with the SIPANI SEVA SADAN by organizing regular visits, fundraising initiatives, and awareness campaigns to address the needs of the elderly community.

The visit to the old-age home was a meaningful and enriching experience for all involved. It reinforced the importance of empathy, compassion, and social responsibility. The department is committed to continuing its efforts to support the elderly residents and contribute to their well-being.
