

At present, she is the head of the Department of English at NMKRV College for Women, Bangalore. She has presented research papers at national and internal conferences and published many research papers in reputed Journals.

The program started by invoking God's blessing, followed by a welcome and Chairperson addresses. Dr. Veena Devi addressed the gathering and motivated them to take up research in various disciplines. She pointed out that a multidisciplinary approach to research will not only widen their horizon of knowledge but also help them to contribute in other areas.
