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A report on Faculty Development Program on

"ERP Software and its Uses"

Date: 28.06.2018 to 29.06.2018

The FDP "ERP Software and its Uses" was conducted for the non-teaching staff. It was conducted in the seminar Hall of our college and twenty members attended this program. The FDP started with the College Anthem followed by the prayer. The IQAC Coordinator, welcomed the guest speaker and the faculty members. She, then welcomed the guest to take over the session.

The resource person was Mr. Suman Nandy, Director, Campus Technology. He spoke on the importance of ERP Softwares to institutions and how their software will cater to the needs of the colleges. He then said that colleges often look for solutions that help them automate key functions such as biometric access, student smart cards, attendance management, etc. He then explained what is ERP software and why it has become mandatory in today's world.

An ERP software will be customised to the needs of the college and it will respond to the modules of Administration, Admission, Examination, Student Support, Staff support and so on so that the management can function in an effective way. He also explained that with these softwares there can be decentralisation of the process and still the control can be with the management. He then gave a small introduction to his ERP Software – Campus Technologies.

On the second day, he spoke in detail about their software. He explained that the Campus Technology suite helps colleges gain better control over day to day operations while offering protection from fraud at a basic level. Campus Technology is a college management software that helps the management to efficiently keep the institution running without any hassle. He proceeded to inform all that their software is user friendly. From his perspective this suite is used by budget conscious colleges that seek to adopt a basic level of automation.

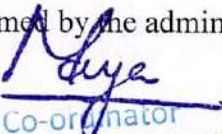


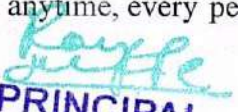
He told that their application is planned for aiding the students of an organization about details on the courses, subjects, classes, assignments, grades and time-table. The administrator would maintain the accounts of the pupil and staff, prepares the time-table and upload the current information regarding the campus. The main problem projected is that the pupil's particulars are reported manually in distinct records, which is a laborious job. Handling and updating these records manually increase the chances of mistakes. It takes a lot of time and needs many employees to accomplish the task. It even lacks security and disability to produce various types of reports.

In order to solve these problems, a new system has been created, that attempts to operate the whole procedure considering the database integration approach. This is where the Campus Technology plays a significant role of making the work easier for the management. He then informed about various features that the software includes like, a single integrated application that automates all processes on the campus for better efficiency and lower costs, secure role based access – control who should see what information, rich feature set of modules covering – Admissions, Fees, Academics, Examinations, Library, Hostel and Payroll to name a few. Dynamic report dashboard – easily create or view different reports. It also provides automation of everyday functionalities like – Timetable, Attendance, Book Issue / Return, Dues Collection etc.

It also provides the Principal and Management more control over the operations of all the processes in the campus and facilitates better informed decisions. Students and staff can view their personal, financial and academic information using the smart card within the campus. Facilitates the academic departments to configure the academic calendar and the lesson plan that helps them monitor academic progress during the entire term. Easily configurable to comply with the rules and regulations prescribed by the affiliated university regarding - admission process, attendance, internals, exam eligibility, course credits and eligibility, student promotion, etc. Information accessible online and calendar scheduling and collaborative features for connecting all stakeholders – via online, Email and SMS functions.

This software makes the admission process easier because the data entered in place are accessible to all people concerned with admissions. This saves a lot of time as well as makes the process less hectic. The installation of the software makes the operational task convenient in a highly effective way. This software system helps to keep watch on all tasks performed by the administrative staff. As the software can be accessed anytime, every person

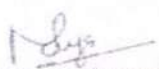

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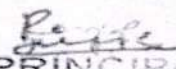

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in the educational departments will be benefitted. This was the overall talk that Mr. Suman had given. The IQAC Coordinator concluded the event with the Vote of Thanks.
