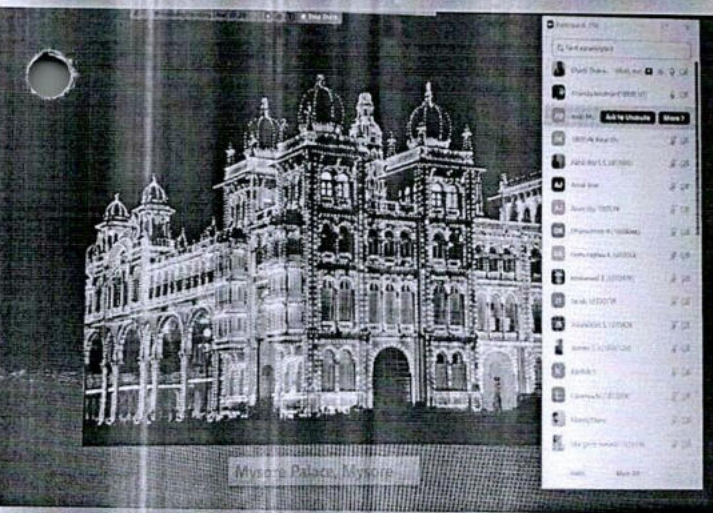
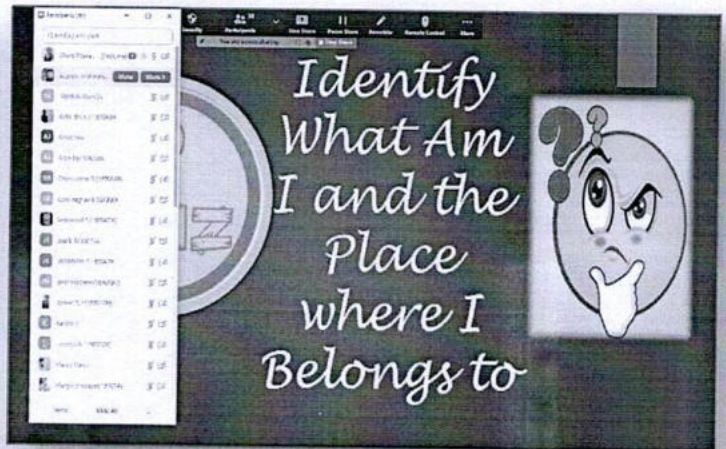
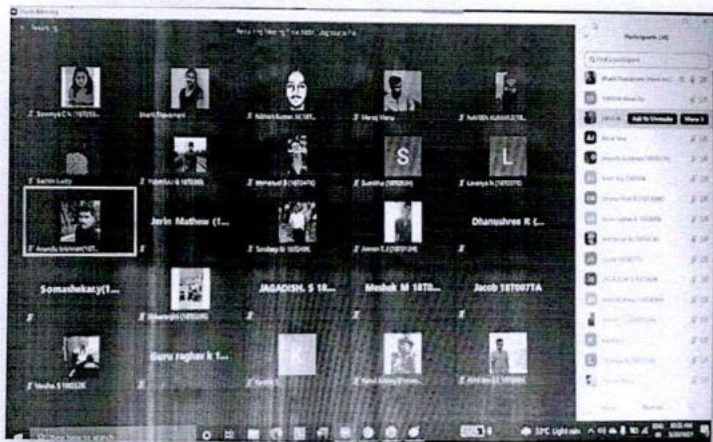

India as one of the biggest tourist hubs. Overall, the activity aimed to bring up awareness about the role played by tourist guides.

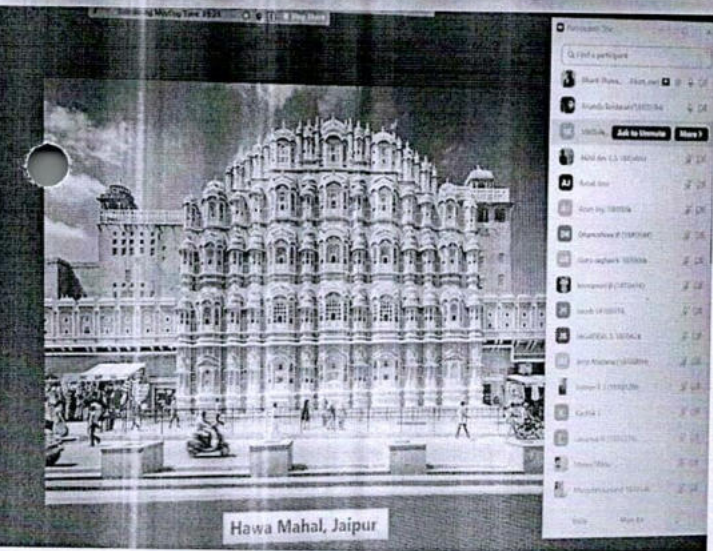

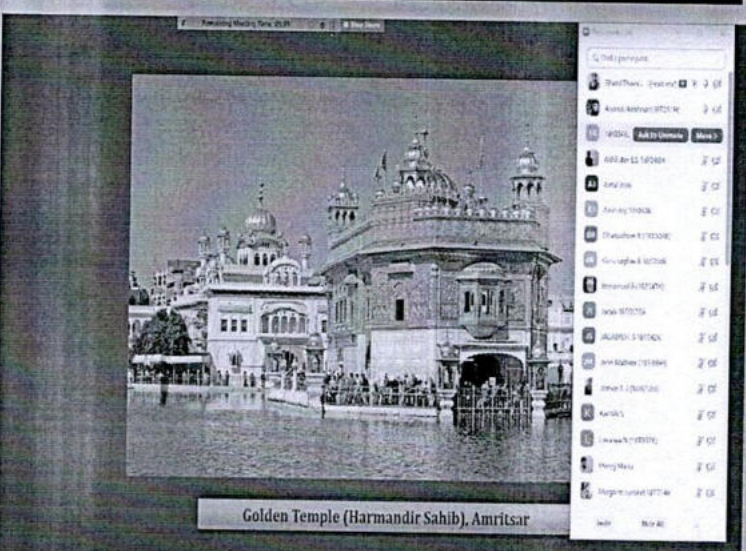
