

There were few **objectives** which were framed for this International Conference and they are as follows:


- aimed to bring intellectuals together, to discuss and learn, to bring latest development in the field of research and to instigate further testing and investigations through research works to build research culture in the society.

The Conference was conducted through online mode (Google Meet) wherein we had almost 200 participants across. We had one keynote speaker, 2 Panelists and 5 moderators for the Conference.

The first Plenary session with Dr Vibhuti Patel was enriching. The panelist presented important objectives of Women Studies. Dr Patel highlighted the importance of research in women studies, contribution of research works in law enforcement or constitution and these works being the milestone for several landmark changes in the society.

The second plenary session was handled by Dr Parvathamma. The panelist defined
