Report

The Postgraduate center along with the Cultural Committee organized "Samanvaya," the Ethnic Day March 18, 2023. The theme for the day was "Festivals of India." It was conducted to celebrate different cultures, traditions, festivals and to bring in the unity. There are various festivals celebrated by us Indians, and many are ignorant about the rituals, food, dress, tradition associated with the festivals. With an intention to bring awareness among the youth the theme "Festivals of India" was chosen. The event was scheduled to happen on March 18, 2023 (Saturday) from 11:40 am onwards. The students were informed earlier regarding the theme, timings, venue, and other things through a brochure. Certain other individual competitions were also conducted like Creative hairstyle, Ramp walk, and Mehendi to make the day fun filled. The registrations for these competitions were done one day before the event and one participant from each department was made mandatory. Students actively participated in the competitions. Rules and regulations were clearly mentioned. Students were informed that for Creative hairstyle and mehendi competitions the models/subjects should be arranged by participants themselves. Creative hairstyle competition and Mehendi competition were conducted at 10:00 am in room no PG001 and PG003 respectively. A time limit of 45+15 mins was given for each competition.

For the Creative hairstyle competitions different hairstyles were done by students and various accessories were used which was very attractive. For the mehendi competition, creative intricate designs were applied by the participants. Judges were from the UG department, PG department, and from the non-academic staff. Different judges were there for each event. The Judges came to the event venue twice to check on the making of hairstyle and mehendi. The judges were given the judging criteria based on which the points were given.

For Creative hairstyle competition, the points were given based on Styling & Finishing, Degree of Hairstyling Difficulty, Creativity, and Overall presentation. For Mehendi competition the points were given based on Attention to details, Intricacy of design, Creativity, and Overall presentation. The winners were announced later in the auditorium.

The actual event began in the Closed Auditorium at 11:40 with a formal and warm welcome to all the faculty and students, which was followed by a prayer song. A group dance was performed by the students to welcome a gathering and bring in the enthusiasm. The platform was open to all the students who were willing to showcase their talents or to share a few words. Many students volunteered to sing, dance, talk and to speak their mind out. Those who came on to the stage voluntarily were given a chocolate as an appreciation. After this, the "Ramp walk" competition began, for which on spot registration was also made. Around 20 participants were there for this event. With music played in background, students with their high spirit and colorful ethnic wear walked across the ramp lively. They were dressed in different festival attires according to the theme. Each participant was given 2+1 mins to talk on their attire and to answer the judge's question. The participants were judged based on Style, Attitude and walk, Costume and designing, Creativity and Overall presentation. Based on the points given by both the Judges the winners were honoured with a Crown and Tiara, that is Mr and Ms. Ethnic.

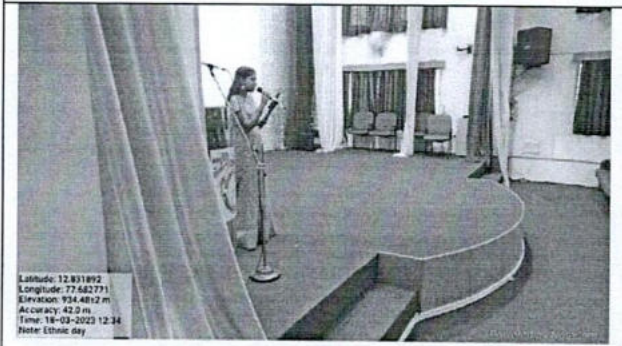
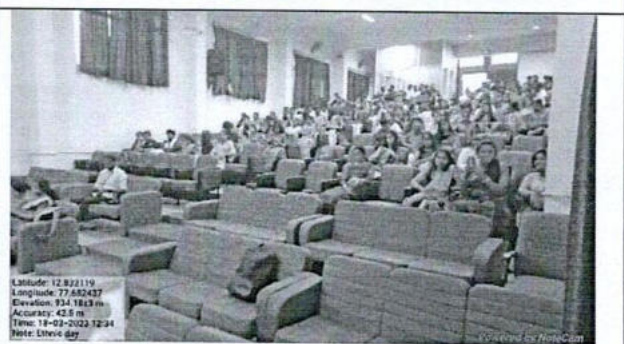
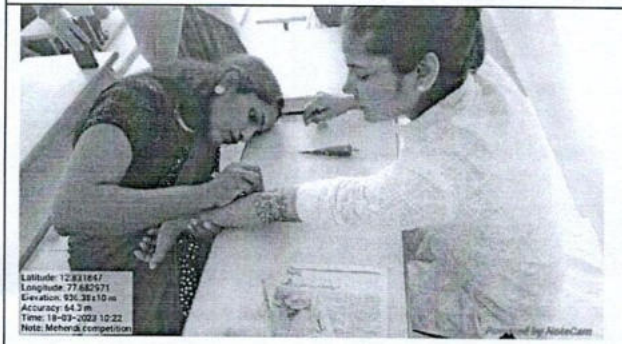
