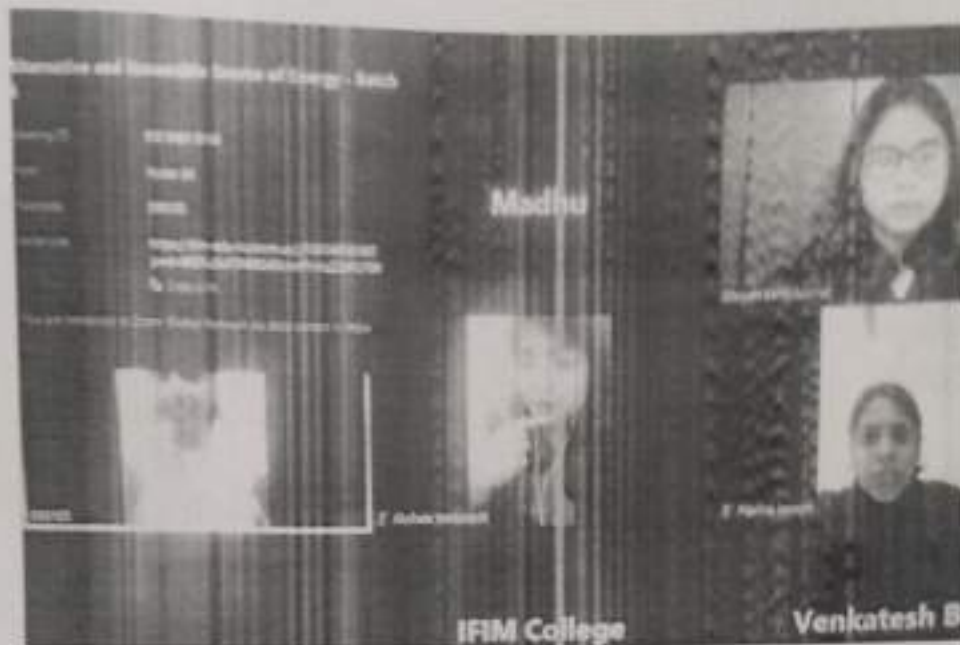
On behalf of Devaline's Nature's Club, the prelims were conducted on 15 Jan 2021. Each participant was given 2-3 minutes for opening statement followed by discussion on the shortlisted topics like Natural Resource Management in Urban Economics, Alternate sources of energy & India energy, New frontiers of green technology for climate action and the like. The selected contestants will be sent to the state level competition, conducted online. Three students were selected, and they were Rency Mathew 2nd year BSC (CJP), Sr.Florina Joseph 2nd year BSC (CJP) and Kavya G.L. 2nd year BA (HEP). These three students represented the college in the regional level competition held on 23 Jan 2021 in zoom platform.

The regional level competition was on the topic 'Alternate and Renewable sources of energy'. There were 47 participants contesting from different parts of Karnataka. Each participant was given 2-3 minutes for opening statement followed by discussion on the major allocated area of deliberation. Participants had to speak about their Vision, Traditional Methods, Role of Technology, Innovation, and Individual Contribution. At the end of all the batches, the winners selected for the grand Finale were announced. Kavya G.L. from 2nd year BA (HEP) was one among the finalists along with Namratha P from ISBR and Aishwarya Chandrashekar from Ramiah Institute of Management.

Ms. Kavya G.L., III semester BA, St. Francis de Sales college, Bengaluru, represented the college in the grand finale held on 26 Jan 2021. The team of three from Karnataka discussed the Zonal Theme, Contribution of Youth and suggested Environmental Collaborative Solutions. Each team got 6 minutes to share their views followed by one question from any one team and one question from the Judge. Two minutes were given to answer the questions. The results of the grand Finale were announced in the presence of Prakash Keshav Javadekar, Minister of Environment, Forest and Climate Change and other dignitaries. Team Karnataka bagged the first prize and Kavya G.L. won the gold medal along with two others in her team. It was a proud moment for Kavya G.L. and St. Francis de Sales college, Bengaluru. She was awarded with a Gold Medal for her overwhelming

participation during the Grand Finale by sharing very relevant and important aspects concerning the theme - Finding collaborative solutions towards Sustainable Environment.

Talk and Demo on 'Compost Grow and Cook

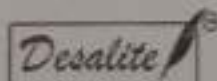
Desalites Nature club live streamed a 'Talk and Demo session on Compost Grow and Cook' organised at *Ragikana*. The Speaker Vasuki Iyengar demonstrated various methods related to potting mix & planting, composting kitchen waste, preparing bio-enzymes, and community composting.

Vasuki Iyengar, the founder of Soil and Health, is a waste management specialist in Bengaluru with 4 years of experience in planning, implementing, and coordinating comprehensive waste management systems that are designed to maximize waste prevention, reuse, and recycling opportunities. Vasuki is also the HR director at I

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Process Info – a Software product company developing safety applications for Oil and Natural Gas Industry. He holds an engineering degree in Computer Science and has served in IT industry for over 22 years.

He lives sustainably by composting kitchen waste using aerobic and anaerobic composting process. He is an expert in preparing bio enzyme, a cleaning liquid made from citrus peels. He believes and lives by the 4R principles – Refuse, Reduce, Reuse, Recycle.

The speech was live streamed through our college's official G-Suite. It was very useful for students to learn about waste management using kitchen waste to make it as compost for home garden. He even explained home-made pots that can be customised using plastic wastes at home. He enlightened the listeners by informing that onion and garlic can be effectively used to make compost for plants. The Speaker explained very clearly about starting terrace gardening, maintaining it and growing fresh vegetables and greens.

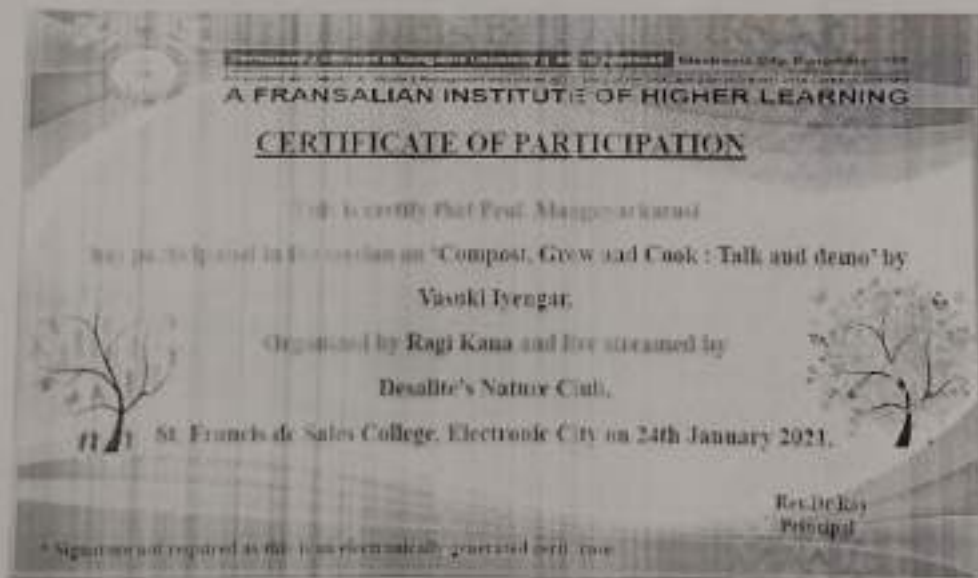
This program informed the participants of waste management ideas, preparing compost from kitchen waste for home gardening, usage of waste plastic wastes to programme make customised pots. The participants expressed their views in the feedback form given to them at the end of the program. 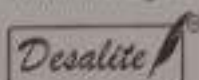

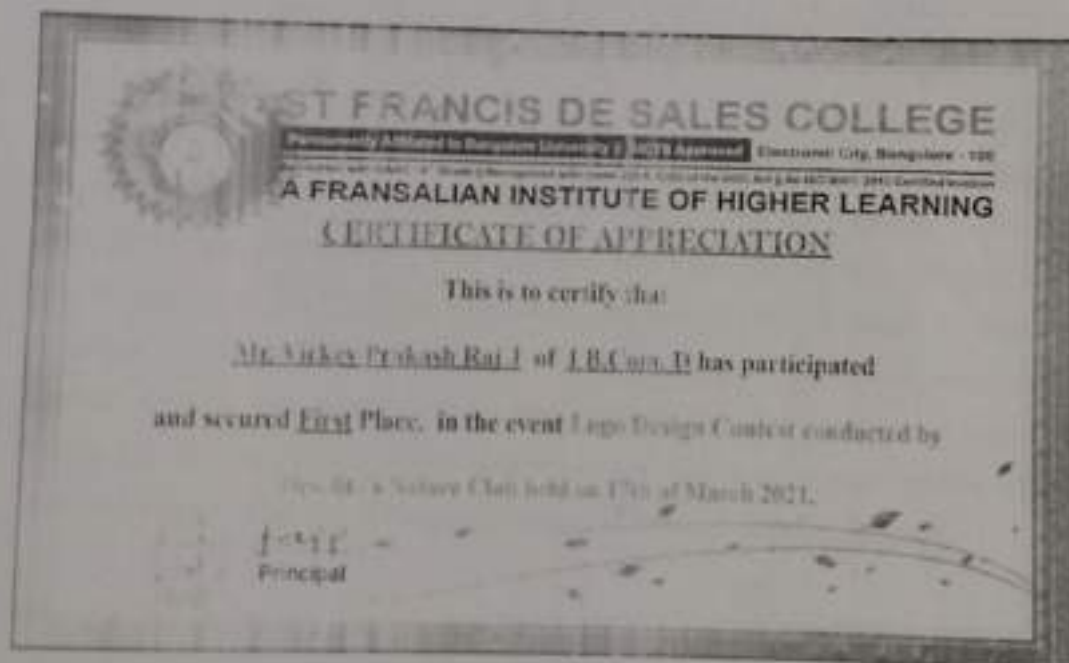

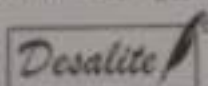
Desalite's Nature Club, St. Francis de Sales College, Electronic City, Bangalore, organised "Name the Tree Trail" Event in the month of March. Trees are important to our lives whether we notice them or not. They supply us with the boards we build our homes with and the oxygen we breathe. Most importantly, they exist not for our use but for their own purposes. Learning to differentiate specific trees can be tricky as leaves from two different species can look very similar, while a single species—or even a single tree—can have leaves that vary in size and shape. Identifying and distinguishing plant species offers a different way of seeing nature that could change our view of the world around us.

Owing to the vast canopy cover in the campus, the event was organised for two days from 18 to 19 March 2021. There were 22 participants who were divided into teams of 4 each to cover the tree trail in the campus. The student team ranged from different disciplines like commerce, science management and arts. Though they were divided in the course of study,

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they were united as Desalite nature club volunteers in this event. Neither the beating sun nor hunger stopped them from tracing the tree trail.

On the first day, the focus was on the tree cover in front of the campus. Since it was pandemic time, only a few volunteers were summoned. The event began with the assembly of students at 9:30 am and had to be wound up at 12:00 pm due to Covid restrictions. The area covered on the first day includes, entrance, bird park, canteen, football court, hostel, and parking. Before the beginning of the event, Deputy Director of Lalbagh Botanical Gardens Bengaluru, G Kusuma, was contacted. She guided the team on the procedures involved in naming the trees. She also instructed to make use of website's like plant lens and plant net for verification. Many students considered it as a unique experience. They went around the campus, taking pics of the leaves, flowers and even the trunk of the trees and plants. They used the apps to identify the names of each focused image. After identification of the names, the trees were coded using the first letter of the botanical name and the total number of plants in the same species were also counted. For example, the palm trees lining the campus entrance were numbered 50.

The second day began with the assembly of Desalite's Nature Club volunteers at 9:30 am and went on till 12:00 pm. The last day covered the back side of the campus which includes, basketball court, areas surrounding the open auditorium, herbal park, butterfly park and the corridors. The second day event saw curious hands searching for the names of the variety of plant species located in the campus. They also took the help of the college Gardener, Mr. Thomas. He shared his expertise with the students and guided them as they went along identifying the scientific names of the plant and tree varieties in the campus. They were astounded at the medicinal value of certain plants in the herbal garden. Students were also informed of the variety of flowering plants that attract butterflies. Volunteers also identified certain new insects inhabiting the trees like rice ear bug and certain types of ants.

The event concluded with the students consolidating the data collected by them. The data contained more than 110 species of plants in the campus. It includes common tree types like palm, mango, jackfruit, papaya, tamarind, teak and coconut. There were herbs, shrubs, trees, creepers, bushes, and ornamental plants. Volunteers like Vicky Prakash Raj, Kavya.G.L, and Mahalakshmi.R did significant contribution to the event by adding boards with botanical names and common names for the plants in the campus. Most students expressed that the event was excellent and had given them a different world view with

sustainable living at the centre of all life and living.

The students were guided by Faculty incharge for Desalite Nature's Club, Dr Madhutamozhi V, Prof. Madhusudan M, Prof. Indra Kumari V. Certificates were issued to the participants after the event. The Desalite's Nature Club is thankful to the management of all the encouragement and support.

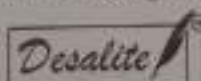

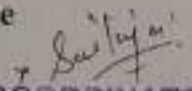

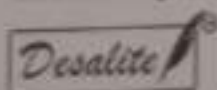

Environment stands for surrounding and it has been defined as the sum total of all conditions and influences that affect the development of an organism. The Quiz was on the Basic Concepts of Environment and Ecology in the form of multiple-choice questions. 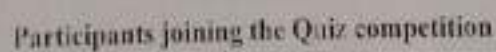
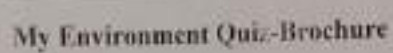

Its goal was to turn the participants into positive change agents who sincerely care for the environment.

Since it was Covid Lockdown time, the event used google meet and slido app to make the quiz more interactive and interesting. The students participated with complete confidence and interest. The event made students understand the mistakes they have done and wrong practices they have followed towards environment. The main aim of the event was not to select winners and runners-up. Thekkanath Steffi Joseph (1 Year BSC CJP) bagged the first prize by answering 17 right answers out of 20, Monika (1 Year BCA) bagged the second prize by answering 16 right answers out of 20 in 5:21 time length and Prashanthi (11 Year MSC Psychology) bagged the third prize by answering 16 right answers out of 20 questions in 5:27 time length.

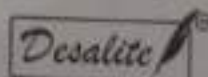
