Department of Humanities

S.No.	Observation	Action taken
1.	All students were satisfied with the curriculum offered	Steps were taken to continue the program in the next academic year also. From the next academic year Bridge Courses will be conducted for more days
2.	From the teacher's feedback it is noted that students are getting benefited by the curriculum.	The IQAC suggested the Journalism department and Sociology Department to involve their students more into media related programs and to be connected with NGOs and take up certificate courses related to Journalism
3.	Alumni feedback mentioned the need of more career -oriented programs	The IQAC suggested the Psychology department to organize personality development programs as part of career counselling.
4.	The employers were satisfied with the performance of our students.	As mentioned in the analysis report, the HOD of the department was instructed to conduct one or two career-oriented programs for the first years and second years also.
