He lives sustainably by composting kitchen waste using aerobic and anaerobic composting process. He is an expert in preparing bio enzyme, a cleaning liquid made from citrus peels. He believes and lives by the 4R principles – Refuse, Reduce. Reuse. Recycle.

The speech was live streamed through our college's official G-Suite. It was very useful for students to learn about waste management using kitchen waste to make it as compost for home garden. He even explained home-made pots that can be customised using plastic wastes at home. He enlightened the listeners by informing that onion and garlic can be effectively used to make compost for plants. The Speaker explained very clearly about starting terrace gardening, maintaining it and growing fresh vegetables and greens.





The college appreciated Kavya GL for her efforts and participation.




The zonal Level competition- Sr.Florina Joseph 2nd year BSC (CJP)





Zonal Level competition- Kavya G L 2nd year BA (HEP)



Desalite's Nature Club, St. Francis de Sales College, Electronic City, Bangalore, organised 'Name the Tree Trail' Event' in the month of March. Trees are important to our lives whether we notice them or not. They supply us with the boards we build our homes with and the oxygen we breathe. Most importantly, they exist not for our use but for their own purposes. Learning to differentiate specific trees can be tricky as leaves from two different species can look very similar, while a single species—or even a single tree—can have leaves that vary in size and shape. Identifying and distinguishing plant species offers a different way of seeing nature that could change our view of the world around us.

Owing to the vast canopy cover in the campus, the event was organised for two days from 18 to 19 March 2021. There were 22 participants who were divided into teams of 4 each to cover the tree trail in the campus. The student team ranged from different disciplines like

commerce, science management and arts. Though they were divided in the course of Electronics City P.O., Bengaluru - 560 100

they were united as Desalite nature club volunteers in this event. Neither the beating sun nor hunger stopped them from tracing the tree trail.

On the first day, the focus was on the tree cover in front of the campus. Since it was pandemic time, only a few volunteers were summoned. The event began with the assembly of students at 9:30 am and had to be wound up at 12:00 pm due to Covid restrictions. The area covered on the first day includes, entrance, bird park, canteen, football court, hostel, and parking. Before the beginning of the event, Deputy Director of Lalbagh Botanical Gardens Bengaluru, G Kusuma, was contacted. She guided the team on the procedures involved in naming the trees. She also instructed to make use of website's like plant lens and plant net for verification. Many students considered it as a unique experience. They went around the campus, taking pics of the leaves, flowers and even the trunk of the trees and plants. They used the apps to identify the names of each focused image. After identification of the names, the trees were coded using the first letter of the botanical name and the total number of plants in the same species were also counted. For example, the palm trees lining the campus entrance were numbered 50.


The second day began with the assembly of Desalite's Nature Club volunteers at 9:30 am and went on till 12:00 pm. The last day covered the back side of the campus which includes, basketball court, areas surrounding the open auditorium, herbal park, butterfly park and the corridors. The second day event saw curious hands searching for the names of the variety of plant species located in the campus. They also took the help of the college Gardener, Mr.Thomas. He shared his expertise with the students and guided them as they went along identifying the scientific names of the plant and tree varieties in the campus. They were astounded at the medicinal value of certain plants in the herbal garden. Students were also informed of the variety of flowering plants that attract butterflies. Volunteers also identified certain new insects inhabiting the trees like rice ear bug and certain types of ants.

The event concluded with the students consolidating the data collected by them. The data contained more than 110 species of plants in the campus. It includes common tree types like palm, mango, jackfruit, papaya, tamarind, teak and coconut. There were herbs, shrubs, trees, creepers, bushes, and ornamental plants. Volunteers like Vicky Prakash Raj, Kavya.GL, and Mahalakshmi.R did significant contribution to the event by adding boards with botanical names and common names for the plants in the campus. Most students expressed that the event was excellent and had given them a different world view with







Students were able to learn the acceptable behaviour towards environment, disciplined activities towards protection of environment.




