To provide an opportunity for students to see and experience real workstations, plants, machines, systems, assembly lines, and interact with highly trained and experienced personnel. This practical learning experience is necessary for students who have to update the real production plant's daily workings.

On 19th Sep 2022, First and Second years along with two faculty members of the Department of Business Administration visited Sharp Polymers which is situated in Bommasandra Industrial Area, Bangalore. Sharp Polymers was established in the year 2016 by Mr. Satish as a single proprietor.

**Sharp polymers a** Leading Plastic Injection and blow moulding company, providing services across the globe and offer the best solutions for products, assembly decorating, and special packaging.

There are total of 130 employees working and the women employees' head count is 35. They operate 24/7 and production didn't stop due to CORONA/the pandemic.

Since the organization unit is manufacturing medical equipment like urine containers, urine caps, and tonner caps etc, Ensured most hygiene within the unit and provided a Disposable cap before entering into the unit. Instructions are given on the safety rules inside the unit.

The students were assembled first and were taken to the unit by Mr. Sajin who is the Assistant Manager of the company have taken inside in batches. The manufacturing process of talcum powder bottles, baby lotion, powder caps, applicators, resonator intake, cool packs, applicator caps, print-it bottles, urine containers, urine caps, and toner caps, was explained. The use of blow moulding to produce Himalayan bottles with 750ml, 400ml, and 50ml bottles was shown. About 65% of products are made for Himalayan brands and produce 1000 bottles per day, Himalayan shampoo of 10000 per day, and piles lotion is produced 30lacs per year. The machines are equipped with the latest technologies and it ensures high quality and efficient working of the unit.


#### The outcome of the Visit:


