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FEEDBACK ANALYSIS REPORT 2022-23

A centralized feedback collection was conducted for the Academic Year 2022-23 from all stakeholders (students, teachers, alumni and industry). Overall responses from all the stakeholders have been positive and satisfactory. Majority of students, teachers and alumni were content with the quality and depth of syllabus, curriculum delivery and teaching-learning strategies adopted during the entire programme. Students and alumnae have stated that they found their respective programmes helpful for pursuing further studies and/ or enhancing career prospects.

Most of the students, teachers and alumnae reported satisfaction with the learning materials provided and they also expressed satisfaction in the overall teaching-learning experience. The potential employers have also given positive feedback on the required skill acquisition and aptitude of our students.

Student Feedback Analysis Report

Majority of the students agreed that the curriculum is relevant to job market. They stated that the teaching-learning is student centric and that they successfully achieve the prescribed course outcomes at the end of each course and thus the institution provides ample prospects for enhancing their research and employability skills. Students are satisfied with the infrastructural facilities. They also mentioned that internship programs helped them to gain better knowledge.

Students mentioned that the institution provides multiple opportunities to learn and grow, they also agreed faculty, provided support as well as assistance for ensuring that they achieve greater heights in academics, co-curricular activities, and personal development. Students voiced a few suggestions for improvement as well. They have mentioned to give more opportunities for experiential learning and increase the number of internship programs.

Teacher Feedback Analysis Report

Feedback analysis done among the teachers clearly underlined the fact that the institution

enhances prospects for higher education/research/employment for the students and that the curriculum is need- based, contemporary as well as skill-based.

They agreed that the syllabus has a good balance between theory and application. Most of the teachers have affirmed that they find teaching-learning activities in the institution as a whole to be student centric and outcome based. They mentioned that tests and examinations are conducted well in time with proper coverage of all units in the syllabus. They also mentioned that provisions for professional development are non-discriminatory and fair.

The teachers gave a few suggestions for improvement as well such as to increase the number of books in library and to frame the Curriculum based on Industry needs.

Alumni Feedback Analysis Report

Most of the former students have expressed satisfaction with the general ambience of the institution. They affirmed that the syllabus is adequate and that the curriculum helps in enhancing skills and subject competency. They also communicated that the learning resources are sufficient and accessible. They also bear witness that the institution enhances chances for higher education and employment. On the whole, the response has been positive from the alumni.

The former students pointed out a few suggestions for improvement such as introducing more Practical sessions for vocational courses and need for general improvement in classroom facilities. They also hinted about the need for introducing more activities to instill a research aptitude in the students.

Employer Feedback Analysis Report

The analysis on industry feedback has shown that the employers are satisfied with the graduate/ post-graduate programmes and they feel that our curriculum enables our students to acquire the sufficient skills for employability. They also affirmed that the candidates have been well equipped with the desired skills for employment in their institution and our students are able to effectively meet the employer/ industry expectations. The potential employers intimated a few suggestions for improvement such as offering more extended internship opportunities for students to ensure optimal industry exposure.
