The objective of the Program:

Field visit has its own place of importance in a career of a student who is pursuing a professional degree course like BSC and BCA. In fact, it constitutes a part of core course curriculum taught at the college. Industrial visits provide the students with an opportunity to learn practically through interaction, and one such objective is achieved by Visiting the VIAT museum, Bangalore. Field visit helps students to combine their theoretical knowledge of with the practical knowledge of its actual functioning. 73 students and 2 faculties participated in this visit to VIAT Museum. The visit started with Science on Sphere show. In this show a fantastic series of images are created by planetary data of high-resolution satellite images and videos, animated images of atmospheric storms, fluctuations in ocean currents, effects of climate change and other complex environmental processes. Followed by this, students visited Electro Technic Gallery, Space Technology Gallery, Biotechnology Gallery, BELL-Hall of Electronics and winded up with a 3D show for 20 minutes. They spent four hours in different galleries which really fascinated the students to see and practice the different theorems they have learned till now.

The outcome of the program:

Industry interaction is also helpful in updating the curriculum when there are significant changes in prevalent technologies and get to know the latest trends. These visit to museums provides an opportunity for students to see and experience real workstations, plants, machines, systems, assembly lines, and interact with highly trained and experienced personnel. This practical learning experience is necessary for students who have to date studied theory only and thus acquaint themselves with the working of instruments during the course curriculum. Students were asked to document their

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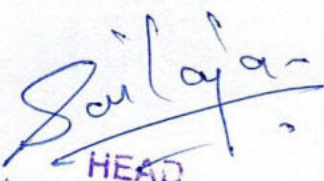
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experiences, challenges faced, and lessons learned during field work. This can help them process and internalize the practical aspects of their learning.
