The research focuses on examining the sanitation and waste management department of BBMP with challenges to maintain cleanliness and manage waste effectively. Their daily tasks including handling and disposing of vast quantities of waste, often in unhygienic conditions. This exposes them to a range of occupational health hazards, including respiratory problems from inhaling pollutants, skin ailments and injuries from handling sharp or contaminated objects. Furthermore the sanitation workers are at an increased risk of contracting diseases due to exposure to unsanitary waste materials and contaminated areas. Inadequate protective gear and limited access to healthcare exacerbate these risks, making it imperative for the BBMP to prioritize the health and safety of its workforce. It is crucial that the BBMP invests in proper training, equipment and healthcare support to safeguard the health of its dedicated personnel, who play a pivotal role in the city's sanitation and waste management efforts. Ultimately, the study concludes that the workers significantly contribute to the success of the sanitation and waste management department of BBMP.

Outcome

Students were able to assess the efforts of sanitation workers and could identify the problems of the workers. They expressed concern about the health of workers and gave some suggestions as well..
