Outcome:

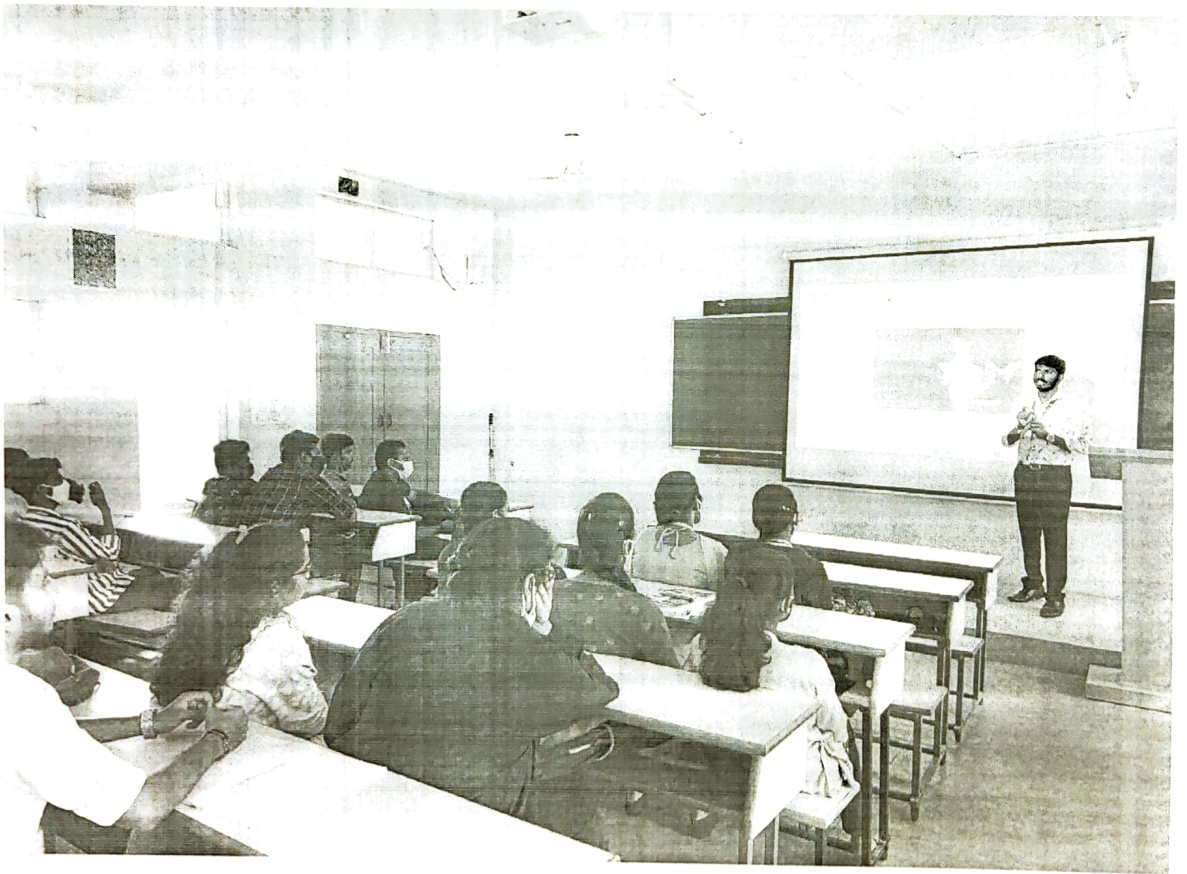
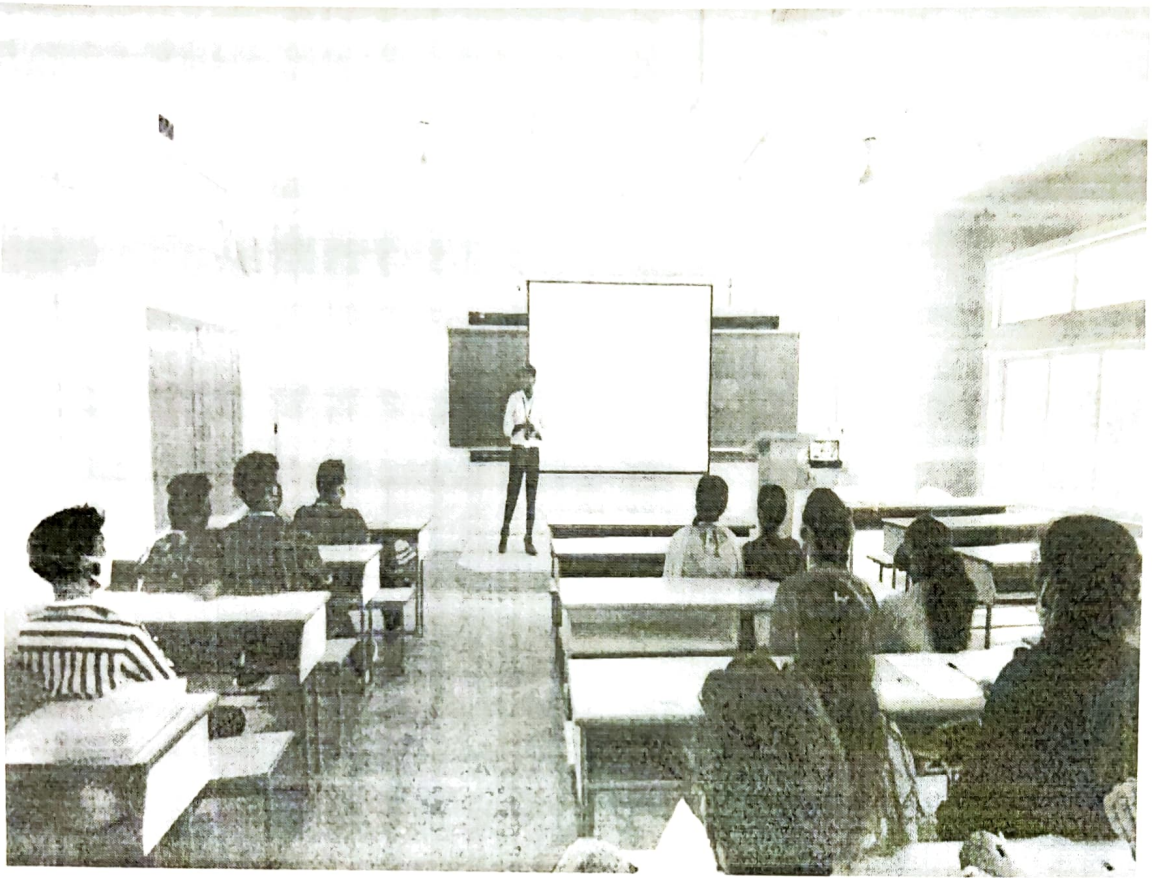
They understood about process of producing and packing in Chocolate Industry.

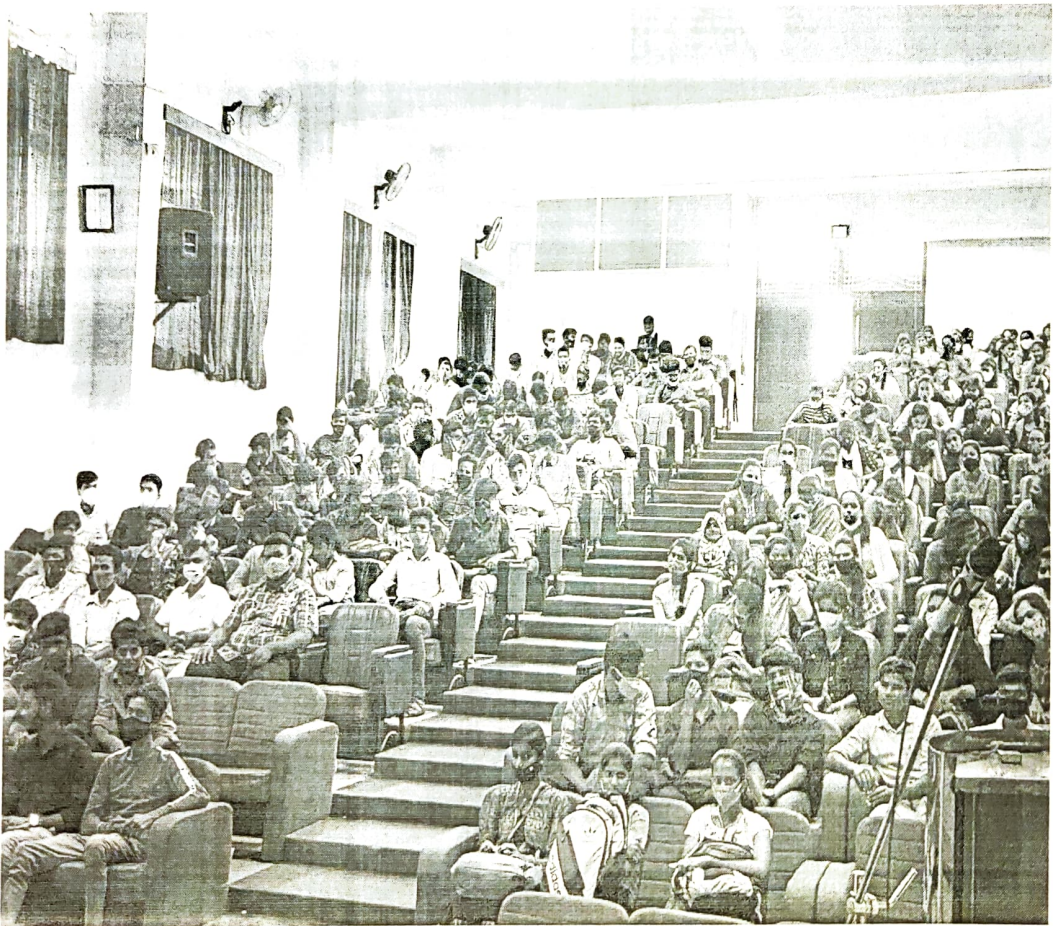
