


Program Outcome are as follows

4. Able to draw conclusions from the data based on powerful statistical analysis.

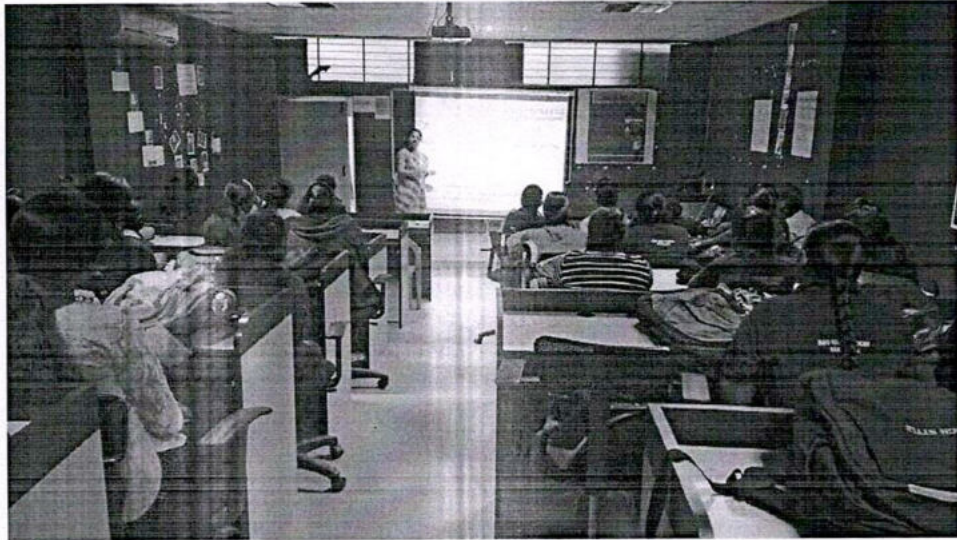
The session was highly fruitful and informative for students and faculty members. The college consistently encourages all the students and faculty to upgrade themselves in ICT tools.
