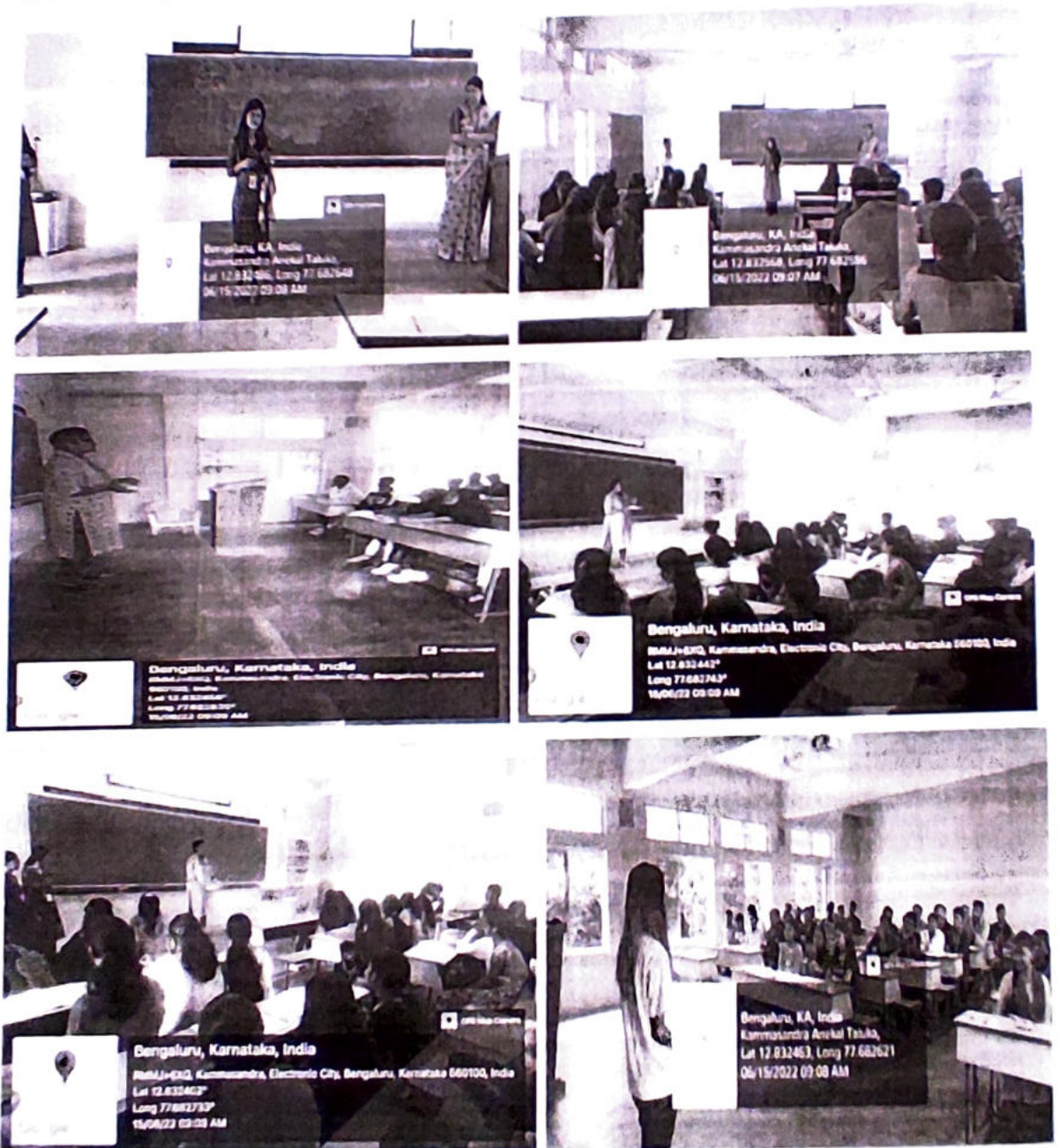

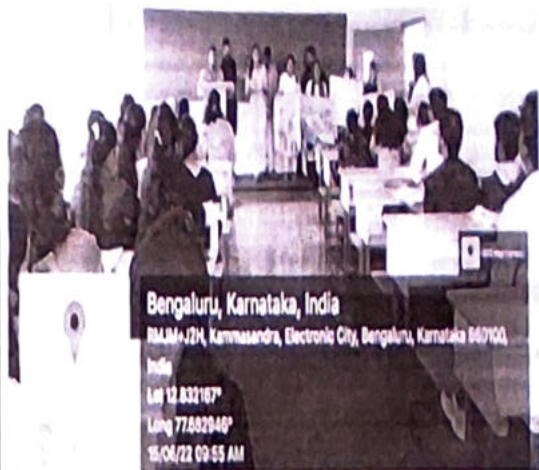
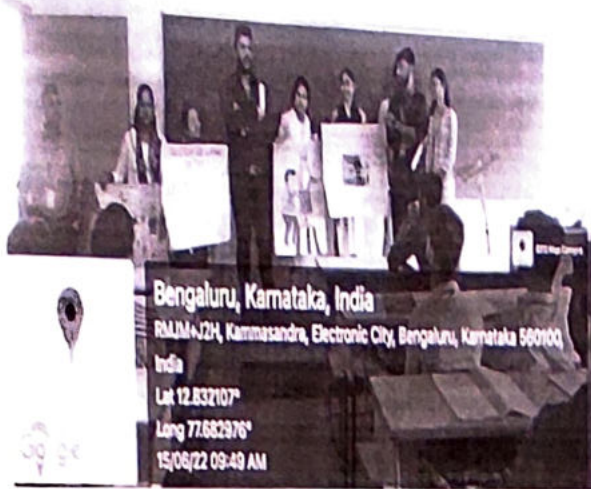
Positive Outcome:

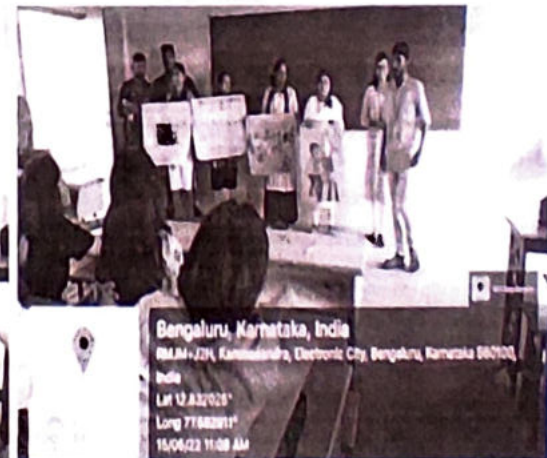
