Three events were organised as part of the celebration. The details of the programmes and events are as follows:

I. Exhibition of posters:

An exhibition of posters on the theme of the national science day celebrations "Women in Science" was conducted. The girl students of second year BSc class took the initiative for the event. The poster exhibition depicted the work and details of around 42 women scientist from around the world. This exhibition could reveal the contribution of women scientists towards the betterment of the society which can be very well related to the importance of educating the girls.

II. Experiment & Experience

The event showcased live experiments and demos. The exhibition gave a real time experience to all those who are interested to experiment science. Various working models from electronics and physics explained many daily life science concepts as well as innovative solutions to many of the problems they face. The chemistry lab showcased a wide range of live experiments like elephant tooth paste, golden rain, chemistry chameleon, vegetable chemistry and facts that helped the visitors to explore the materials that they use in daily life

like cosmetics, dyes, etc. Experiment and experience made the visitors from other disciplines to experience the fun and facts through models and experiments.
