INDUSTRIAL VISIT REPORT

On 31st August 2021, we final year students of M.com along with two faculty members of **St. Francis de Sales College** visited **Sharp Polymers** which is situated in Bommasandra, Bangalore. This place is situated within 3-kilometre radius of the college. It is popular Industrial area in Bangalore.

We left our college campus at 10:30 am and reached our destination at 10:45 am. We have travelled by our college bus itself and two faculty members to guide us throughout. There were two buses provided by the college as a protocol to be followed during pandemic situations.

We arrived at the industry at 10:45am. The industry was established in the year 2016 by **Mr. Satish** as a single proprietor. There are total of 130 employees working and women employees head count is 35. They operate 24/7 and production didn't stop due to Corona.



Since the organisation unit is manufacturing medical equipment like urine container, urine cap, tonner cap etc, Ensured at most hygiene with in the unit. They provided Disposable cap before entering into unit. Instructions given on the safety rules inside the unit.

We were assembled first and were taken to the unit by MR. sajin who is Assistant manager of the company then we were taken inside in batches so that mess is not created. They manufacture powder bottle, baby lotion, powder cap, applicator, resonator intake, cool pack, applicator cap, print it bottle, urine container, urine cap, tonner cap etc.

They use blow moulding for producing Himalayan bottles. They produce 750ml, 400ml and 50ml bottles. Navagan cool pack is of 300ml. They use high density polythene combination. Polypropylene is used for food products. 65% of Himalayan products are produced there. At first granules are received from suppliers then it is preheated and are put for melting. Next is Brisson, after that mould will be closed and the bottle will be made.


They have capacity to produce 1000 big bottles per day, Himalayan shampoo of 10000 per day and piles lotion is produced 30lacs per year. The machines are equipped with latest technologies and it ensures high quality and efficient working of the unit.

At the end there was a felicitation given to the proprietor of the company **Mr.Satish** by our faculty **Dr.Gurubasavaraja** and **Dr.Thana Packiam**.

We left the premises at 13:00 pm. the visit was indeed knowledgeable and a good learning experience.
