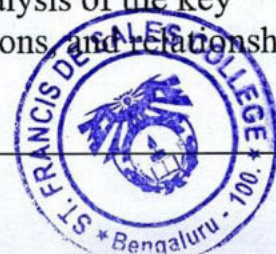

Followed by the lecture, participants had the opportunity to engage in question answer session. Attendees asked thought-provoking questions related to the themes, characters and writing style of the novel.





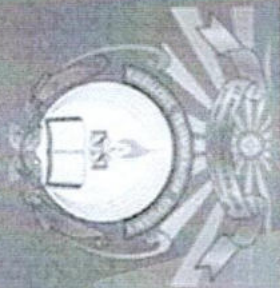

**The objective of the Program:**

The objective of the Guest Lecture series was knowledge acquisition and nurturing research culture among students.

**Report:**

The Department of English organized a two-day Guest Lecture on the topics "Sounds and Rhythm in English Language and Research and the Researcher – A Perspective on the 19<sup>th</sup> and 21<sup>st</sup> of April 2023.

The resource person for the first lecture series was Dr. Deepthi S, Assistant Professor of English, GFGC, Channapatna. The resource person spoke on the topic "Sounds and Rhythm in English Language". She explained about the syllabification of the English language and interacted with the students through language games. She taught the students about the chin-palm rule for understanding the concept of stress. She also explained the rules governing the word stress. The elements of sentence stress were also discussed. A clipping from "My Fair Lady" was played for the students to understand the English language's beauty.

Dr. Veena Devi R S, HOD – Department of English, NMKRV College for Women, Bangalore was the resource person on 21<sup>st</sup> April 2023. The topic of discussion was "Research and the Researcher – A Perspective". She spoke about the importance of research and every student should develop the mindset of a researcher. She explained that critical thinking is the key to research. She took the case study of BGL Swamy and Poorna Chandra Tejaswini to explain the importance of research to the students. Their interest in research made them contribute immensely to the human community. She wished that all students should become researchers and develop the research culture in India.
