



Various Resource persons of expertise dealt on topics including Online Resources and Tools for Teaching, Learning and Research. The last day of the Seminar had a presentation by Dr Ponmudi, Advisor, NAAC.

This first online FDP organised by the College was attended by over 200 participants spanning around 55 colleges and universities across the country.

On day1 The program started with a prayer and principal welcomed all the gathering. Mr. Suman Nandy explained about the various open source software that are required for teaching and learning during the pandemic situation. He introduced the various open source tools that are useful for online teaching, he explained how to implement it virtually, how to assign assignments to students, how to conduct live classes etc. He concluded by telling that technology plays a major role in imparting education to this generation in an interesting manner. Executing digital methods in teaching will help students to access the information quickly and grasp the concepts easily. The session ended with question and answers Mr. Suman clarified all the dobuts that were asked by the faculties.

On day 2 in session 1 Dr. Maria Priya spoke about how sample size calculation and citation can be done using online resources, she explained how to go about the literature review, Bibliography and how to make use of grammarly while writing a research paper. The session was very interactive, useful and informative.

Session 2 was handled by Dr. Nebula Murukesh, she spoke about how to go about research publications, what are the steps that are to be followed. She also explained how to search for research papers, and about the online resources that are available for writing an effective research paper. She also spoke about the various journals that are available for publications. The session was concluded by question and answers.

On day 3 session 1 was handled by Dr. Smrity Prasad, she explained about the importance of Google classrooms and how it is useful to both teachers as well as students. She explained how to create a google classroom, how to, share notes conduct tests, schedule and collect assignments, and how to evaluate the answer sheets and give feedback to students.

Session 2 was handled by Prof. Nayana K.V, she gave an idea on how to conduct survey with the help of survey monkey and how it is useful in online education. She explained how to create a survey form, collect data and analyze it.

Session 3 was conducted by Prof. Lakshmi .C.B who explained on how to create google forms for online classes, she explained how to create MCQ questions and quiz using google form, the steps that are involved in creating these forms and how it is useful for online assessment of students.

Session 4 was conducted by Dr. Lokanayaki, who explained about the advantages of google drive, she spoke about the uses of google drive, its storage capacity and

also explained how to create and upload files and folders in google drive, how to save the documents etc.

All the 4 sessions were very informative and useful, all doubts were cleared by the resource persons during the question and answer session.

On day 4 session 1 was handled by Prof. Sailaja, she spoke about how to make use of google meet for online classes. The concepts like how to create a meeting link, how to share it to students, features of google meet were explained, she also spoke on how to share a presentation, or a Video while taking online class through google meet.

Session 2 was followed by Prof. Alisha Verghese who explained the platforms like zoom and webex for taking live online classes, she explained about the features, differences and the properties of both the platforms and how both are useful for online classes, the various settings of both the platforms were also explained for the smooth conduct of classes.

Session 3 was handled by Prof. Annie Christilla, who spoke about the various online research tools that are used to create lists of the most cited scientific articles. She gave idea on google scholar, digital libraries, and Various Research Tools for Data Analysis. She explained about Sci Hub, which is a shadow library website that provides free access to millions of research papers and books, without regard to copyright.

All the three sessions were very informative and concluded with question answer session.

On day 5 the Resource person was Prof. Ponmudi, Advisor NAAC. He spoke on online Teaching, Learning and Assessment using ICT from NAAC Prespective. He focused on areas like What impact does teaching style have? How to plan a course curriculum? How to make lectures, classes, and laboratories more effective? How to tell what students are thinking? All these points were explained with respect to NAAC Prespective.

The importance of effective methods of teaching different subjects and conducting timely assessments were also explained. He also explained the importance of Research and publications with respect to NAAC. The session was interactive and participants cleared their doubts during question and answer session.

The session concluded by proposing vote of Thanks and Thanking all the resource persons for sharing their knowledge.

The five days online fdp was very useful and informative and interesting. The sessions helped everyone in understanding how to conduct online classes during the pandemic situation. It also helped to understand about the online resources and tools used for research and publications.
