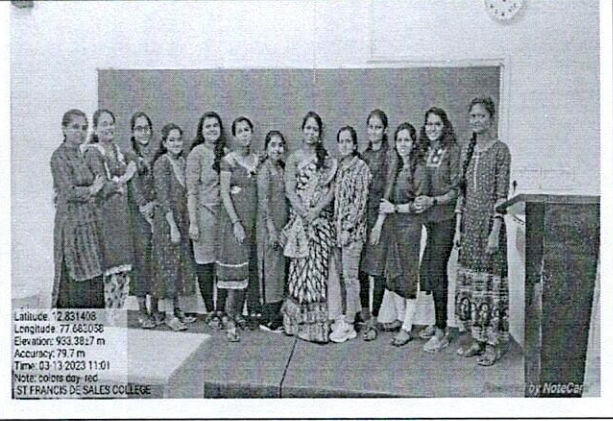
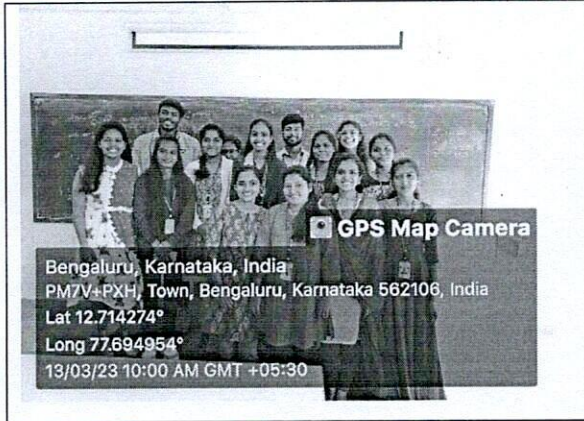

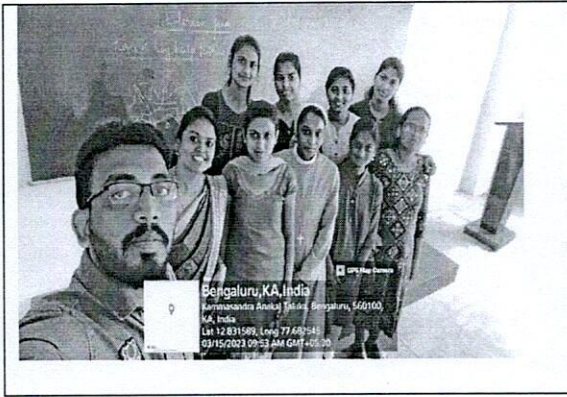
## Day 2: YELLOW
