Report on Basic Hindi Learning Certificate Course 2021

Title of the Course: Curriculum Enrichment Cell- Basic Hindi Learning Certificate Course

Date of Commencement: 22 Feb 2021 to 14 March 2021

Course Objectives:

This course will help them to learn the concepts through digital media and to encourage students who are willing to learn the language by making learning available for them.

Course Structure:

Basic Hindi Learning Certificate Course has three Modules. In Module – 1, students learn about Svar and Vayanjan. They were first introduced to the vowels and then recited them along with the teacher. They then moved onto writing each letter. Each vowel was presented and explained how to write. They were given time to practice each vowel. In the end, the vowels were revised again by forming words with each vowel. The image of the word was displayed for visual learning. In Module – 2, students were taught about how to make words. In this they learnt about one Matra words, two Matra words and three Matra words. They learnt about vegetables, fruits names and 1 to 100 numbers. The image of the word and picture was displayed for visual learning. In Module-3 students learnt about framing sentences. All the three Modules of the course includes seven sessions that are voice-over recorded power point presentations. The videos were uploaded on YouTube and the links for the same were made available for the students. For each Module, students were given two assignments and one quiz. Students must score 40% marks to get their certificate.
