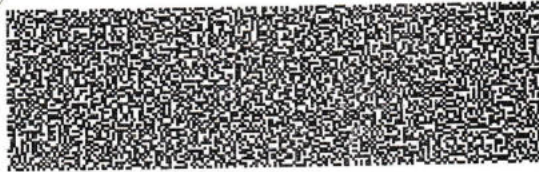

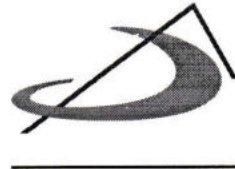

St. Francis de Sales College (SFS COLLEGE), Bengaluru

St. Francis de Sales (SFS) College is manned by the Missionaries of St. Francis de Sales (MSFS) of South West India Province, who firmly believe that 'the education of the heart is the heart of education' hailed by its founder Fr. Peter Marie Mermier.

SFS College came into existence in 2004 with the motto: Excellence, Transformation and Efficiency. It is a minority recognized institution which is permanently affiliated to Bengaluru University. The College was granted "A" grade by the NAAC in 2015. The Postgraduate Centre was added to the College in 2017. In the year 2018, the College obtained 2(f) and 12(b) recognition under the UGC Act of 1965. AICTE approval was obtained in 2020 to begin regular MBA Program from 2020-21. The College is also an ISO certified Institution.

St Paul's Institute of Communication Education for Women (SPICE for Women), Mumbai

St Paul's Institute of Communication Education for Women (SPICE for Women), is administered by the Bombay Society of Saint Paul Trust, who firmly believe in their founder Blessed James Alberione's maxim and his ardour for using social communication as a modern means of outreach. As is their mission, SPICE for Women will 'continually explore a curriculum that is globally engaging, locally relevant, and responsive to the new challenges'.

Established in 2018, located in Bandra West, SPICE for Women, affiliated to the University of Mumbai, aims understand the complexity of modern communication technology and improve the employability of women students, and in view of the increasing number of jobs available within mass media.



Purpose of the MOU

The purpose of this Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) is to formally create a mutually beneficial working relationship between St. Francis de Sales College and St Paul's Institute of Communication Education For Women.

In particular, the MOU is intended to

- To support towards Academic exchange (Student/Faculty/internship/etc) Program
- To jointly propose and engage in research or training programmes sponsored by funding agencies, and to invite each other's faculty and students to participate therein
- To jointly organize seminars, conferences, or workshops on topics of mutual interest and to invite each other's faculty and students to participate therein
- To create an Ecosystem for innovation and knowledge transfer
- To exchange information on research and educational programmes
- To exchange, on a reciprocal basis, Faculty and Students at Undergraduate and Post-Graduate levels for limited periods of time for the purpose of education and/or research.

Duration

This MoU is for a period of 3 years. It can be extended further by mutual consultation and agreement.

Co-ordinators

- St. Francis de Sales College: Mr Druva Kumar, Coordinator, Academia-Industry Interaction Cell will serve as the Coordinator. He along with Fr Jijo Manjackal, Vice Principal, will sign as witnesses in the MoU document.
- St Paul's Institute of Communication Education for Women, Mumbai: Ms. Joulyn Kenny will serve as Coordinator. He / She along with Fr Renold Pascal, Vice Principal, will sign as Witnesses in the MoU document.

The respective Coordinators of SFS COLLEGE and St Paul's Institute of Communication Education for Women shall be responsible for all the communication between the two institutions and the implementation of the proposed objectives of the MoU.

Administration of the signed MoU

- This MoU shall be effective and will come into force from the day the two authorized signatories of both the parties formally sign the MoU document.
- The authorized signatories and / or the Coordinators of SFS COLLEGE and St Paul's Institute of Communication Education for Women will



- Implement this MoU and all endeavours that derive from it.
- Develop and carry out joint plans for the implementation of the objectives of the MoU by having regular communications.
- Additional activities proposed within the framework of the general terms of this Memorandum of Understanding will be formally incorporated as an addendum to this MoU, provided the addendum is agreed to and signed by both the parties.
- Both SFS COLLEGE and St Paul's Institute of Communication Education for Women shall inform in writing the respective communities of this MoU to draw benefits from it and to contribute towards its implementation in spirit and substance.

Termination / Amendment of MoU

- Both the parties will endeavour to resolve disputes arising between them in relation to this MoU by amicable means. If this not possible because of irreconcilable differences, then this MoU may be terminated by mutual consent of the two parties.
- Either party may terminate this MoU by written notification signed by the appropriate official of the institution initiating the notice.
- A minimum of three months prior notification must be sent to the other party prior to the effective date of termination.

Intellectual Property Rights

Intellectual Property developed by the joint efforts would be the joint property of the Parties and any financial benefits or otherwise arising out of it shall be shared proportionately by the parties in consonance with the efforts / inputs given by them.

Jurisdiction

All disputes are to be settled within the jurisdiction of Bengaluru courts, State of Karnataka.
