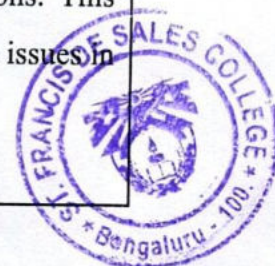

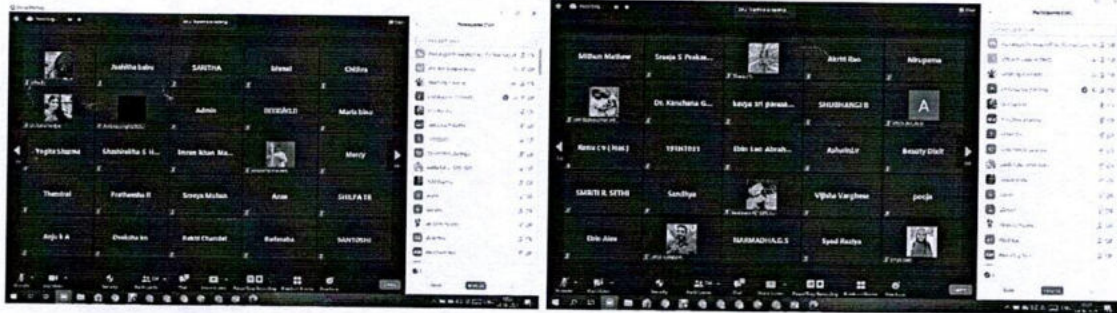
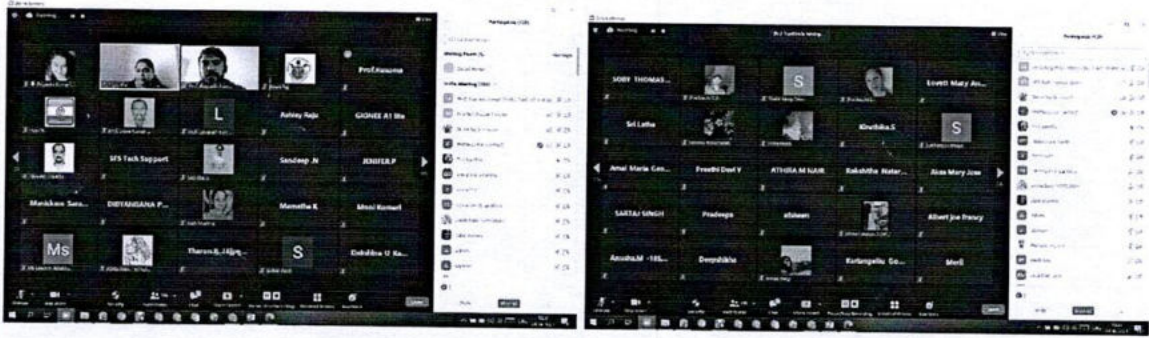

She has undertaken many minor projects and her on-going major project is "Availability and Accessibility of Government Welfare Measures: A Case Study of Transgender Community in Tamil Nadu" funded by ICSSR-IMPRESS Project. She also received many awards from various organisations.

The seminar began with a prayer by Tressa Sonia of 2nd year M.Sc. Psychology and then the inaugural address was delivered by Rev. Fr. Dr. Roy, Principal of SFS College. The presidential address was delivered by Prof. Kusuma R., Head of Department of Humanities. Then the session was handed over to the resource person Dr. J Vanitha to deliver the keynote address. The keynote speaker gave a conceptual framework on the theme of the seminar by focusing on three separate concepts in the theme of the seminar i.e. women, gender and migration. Speaker also focused on the correlation of these concepts and issues involved with it.

After the keynote address the technical session began. A total of 33 research papers were presented by the students of UG and PG across India through the online platform. The technical session was divided into 3 parts. Each session had 10 to 13 research papers. The entire session was hosted by Priyanka Kumari of 1st year B.A. The seminar concluded with vote of thanks delivered by Prof. Lakshmi Balakrishnan.

The seminar successfully attained its aim by providing a platform for the student scholars to discuss the different dimensions of women issues. Moreover, it gave a strong platform for the students to be involved in research and understand the various methods of research and how to use those methods in presenting the research paper. It also increased the confidence of students to address a large number of audiences. More importantly this seminar gave the students to understand any concepts with theoretical background rather than layman knowledge.

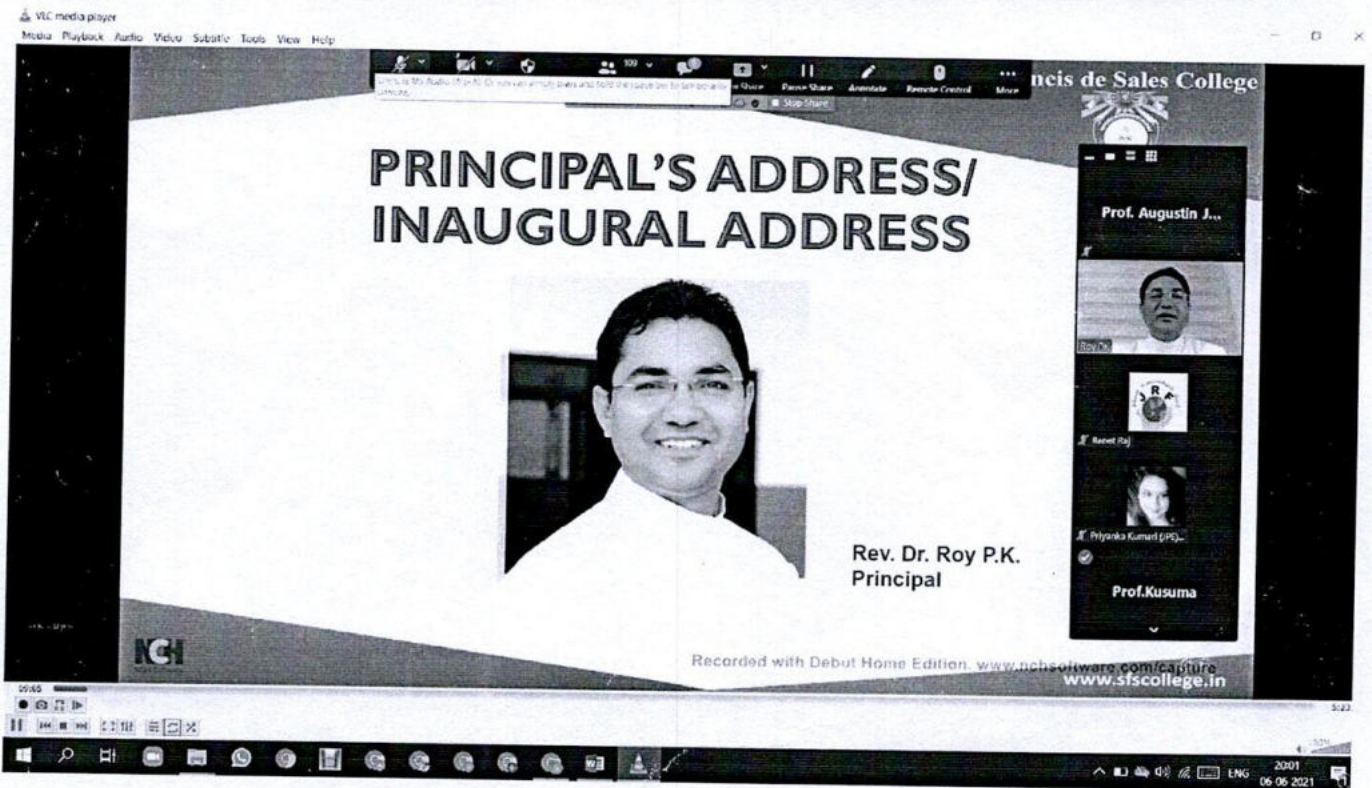
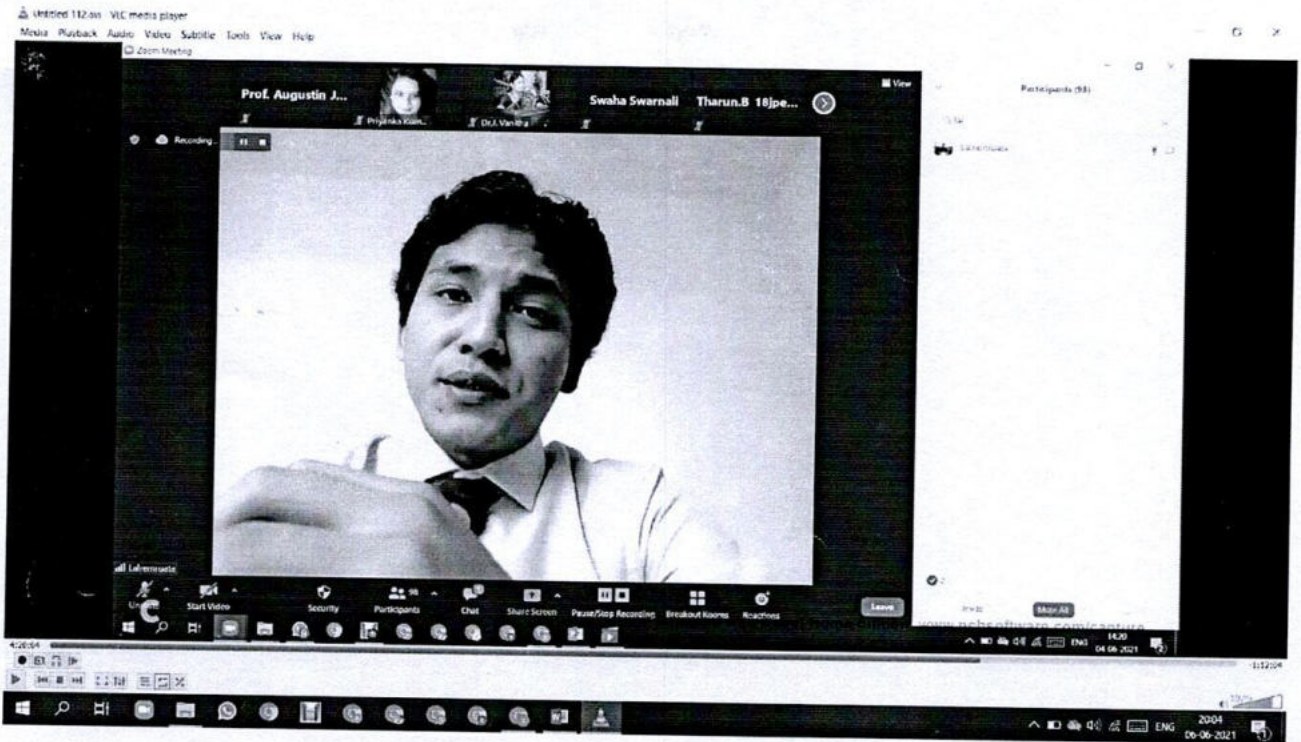
