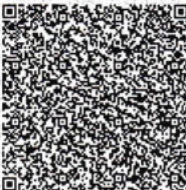

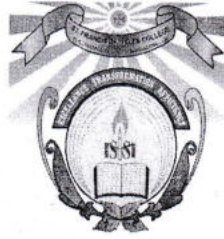

SCC is NAAC accredited, permanently affiliated to Bangalore University, and is managed by St. Claret Educational Society. Over the past decade and a half, SCC has chartered an impressive growth, developing thousands of young men and women for professional lives and service to humanity. Currently, SCC shapes the future of more than 2000 students enrolled across 11 undergraduate and two post graduate courses.



St. Francis De Sales College (SFS), Bangalore

St. Francis de Sales College, popularly known as SFS College, Electronic City, Bangalore is managed by St. Francis Sales Educational and Charitable Trust. St. Francis de Sales College came into existence in 2004 with the motto: Excellence, Transformation, and Efficiency. It is permanently affiliated with Bangalore University. The Postgraduate Center was added to the College in 2017. In the year 2018, the College obtained 2f and 12b recognition under the UGC Act of 1965. With the AICTE approval, professional courses such as MBA and BBA Aviation Management were started in 2020. It is also an ISO-certified institution.

Purpose of MOU

The purpose of this Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) is to formally create a mutually beneficial working relationship between St. Claret College and St. Francis De Sales College.

In particular, the MOU is intended to

- To support towards Academic exchange (Student/Faculty/internship/etc) Program
- To collaborative efforts towards Research and Consultancy
- To jointly organize Conferences / FDP/ Seminars/ Workshops/ Training Programs
- To create an Ecosystem for innovation and knowledge transfer

Duration

This MoU is for a period of 5 years. It can be extended further by mutual consultation and agreement.

(Note: MoU with institutions / industry / NGOs will be for a maximum of three years.)

Co-ordinators

- St. Claret College: Dr./Ms./Mr. KAGENDRA T., Asst Prof. / Assoc. Prof./ Professor in the Department of SCIENCES will serve as Coordinator.
- St. Francis de Sales College: Mr. Druva Kumar, Asst Prof. will serve as Coordinator. He / She along with Rev. Fr. Jijo Jose, Vice Principal will sign as Witness in the MoU document.



- St. Francis de Sales College: Mr. Druva Kumar, Asst Prof. will serve as Coordinator. He / She along with Rev. Fr. Jijo Jose, Vice Principal will sign as Witness in the MoU document.

The respective Coordinators of SCC and SFS shall be responsible for all the communication between the two institutions and the implementation of the proposed objectives of the MoU.

Administration of the signed MoU

- This MoU shall be effective and will come into force from the day the two authorized signatories of both the parties formally sign the MoU document.
- The authorized signatories and / or the Coordinators of SCC and SFS will
 - implement this MoU and all endeavours that derive from it.
 - develop and carry out joint plans for the implementation of the objectives of the MoU by having regular communications.
- Additional activities proposed within the framework of the general terms of this Memorandum of Understanding will be formally incorporated as an addendum to this MoU, provided the addendum is agreed to and signed by both the parties.
- Both SCC and SFS shall inform in writing the respective communities of this MoU to draw benefits from it and to contribute towards its implementation in spirit and substance.

Termination / Amendment of MoU

- Both the parties will endeavour to resolve disputes arising between them in relation to this MoU by amicable means. If this not possible because of irreconcilable differences, then this MoU may be terminated by mutual consent of the two parties.
- Either party may terminate this MoU by written notification signed by the appropriate official of the institution initiating the notice.
- A minimum of three months prior notification must be sent to the other party prior to the effective date of termination.

Intellectual Property Rights

Intellectual Property developed by the joint efforts would be the joint property of the Parties and any financial benefits or otherwise arising out of it shall be shared proportionately by the parties in consonance with the efforts / inputs given by them.





All disputes are to be settled within the jurisdiction of Bangalore courts, State of Karnataka.

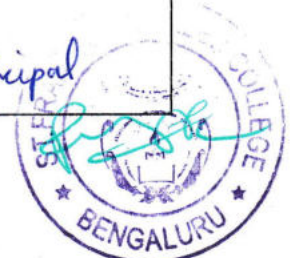
Undertaking by SCC and SFS College
