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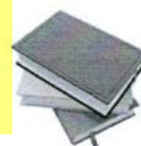



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TOURISM MANAGEMENT PRACTICES AT LOKTAK LAKE, MANIPUR



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ABSTRACT

Being the largest freshwater lake in South Asia, Loktak Lake of Manipur, India is a popular biodiversity destination. It is the home for the Keibul Lamjao National Park - the only floating national park in the world.
