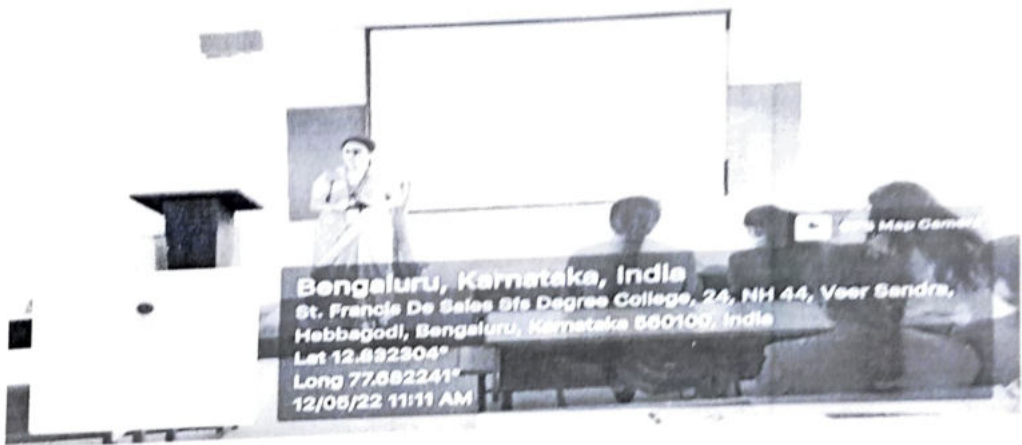
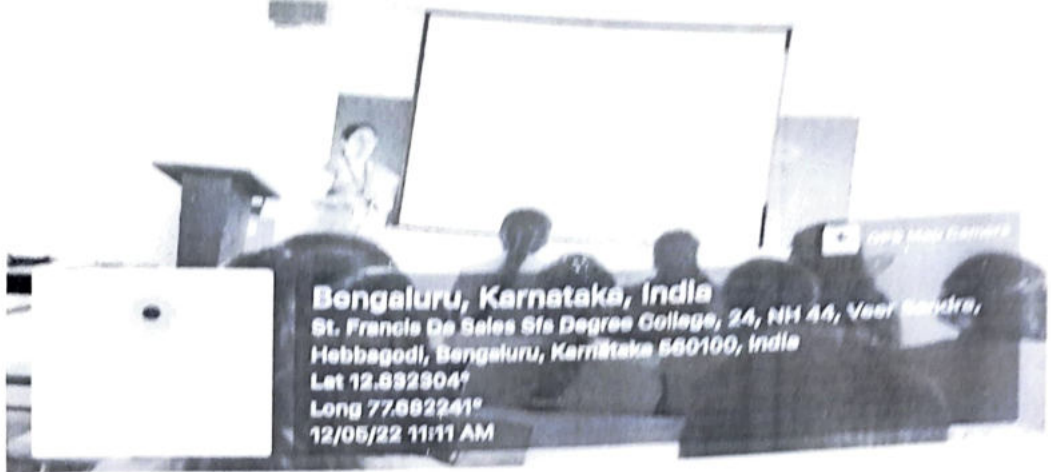
A short movie on Ethics was screened and then followed by question answer session where faculty had posted few situations and interacted with students on how they would react to those situations. Few situations discussed were,

Question	Characteristics
<b>Scientific</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Asks testable questions about the natural world</li> <li>• Can be explored through scientific inquiry and observation</li> <li>• Relies on empirical and measurable evidence</li> </ul> <p>Example: How does a kidney function in the body?</p>
<b>Religious/Cultural</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Asks us what would be in line with a particular religious belief or practice, or the common practices of a particular culture</li> </ul> <p>Example: What does my religion or culture say about whether it's acceptable to donate a kidney?</p>
<b>Legal</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Asks us what the law says about a particular issue</li> <li>• Ethics may inform the law, but sometimes laws are unethical and sometimes the ethically right thing to do may be illegal</li> </ul> <p>Example: Is it legal to sell kidneys in the United States?</p>
<b>Ethical</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Asks us what the right thing to do is - what we should or ought to do - in the face of a moral dilemma</li> <li>• Often arises out of a conflict in values among individuals or groups</li> <li>• Requires moral reflection, making evaluations and judgments about responsibilities, rights, duties, values, and principles</li> </ul> <p>Example: "Should individuals who donate kidneys be allowed to choose who their organs should go to?"</p>
