

Earth Day is an annual event on April 22 to demonstrate support for environmental protection. First held on April 22, 1970, it now includes a wide range of events coordinated globally by EarthDay.org including 1 billion people in more than 193 countries. It is an international event celebrated around the world to pledge support for environmental protection. The year 2021 marks the 51st anniversary of the annual celebrations.



This year's theme for Earth Day is 'Restore Our Earth'. In 2009, the United Nations designated April 22 as 'International Mother Earth Day'. This day provides an opportunity to raise public awareness around the world to the challenges regarding the well-being of the planet and all the life it supports. The Department Association for Chemistry, Kanika, Department of Science conducted an online contest, "Know your Plant". The students of the college were asked to send a photo of any plant in their proximity or neighbourhood and made a write up on the plant. A total of 34 students participated in the contest. All the participants were given participation certificates on submission of feedback forms. Ananya V of II Semester BCom F/A won the first prize, Jhanvi S., IV Semester BSc (PCM) won the second prize and Harshitha N., IV semester BBA Section A won the third prize in this contest.

The contest could make the students look at the plants near to them and know its importance. A wide range of plants were identified by students and written on its features and uses. In feedback students expressed different ways how they are contributing and are planning to contribute to restore the earth. 95 % chose their contribution as planting trees and plants remaining they showed their concern on plastic pollution and the reducing the use of plastics as their contribution towards restoring the mother earth.



### Report

Laboratory training is an integral part of science education. Laboratory training involves experimentation which involves observation, testing and reproducibility of data (collected during laboratory investigations). An important issue with laboratory training is safety of the students. Inculcating safety practices in laboratory learning is an important aspect of education for students. Creating awareness about safe laboratory practices and first aid measures is very crucial for safe laboratory experience. In Chemistry laboratories, students deal with a large number of chemicals. These chemicals must be used with utmost care as these are dangerous for human exposure.

A tutorial on safety symbols and MSDS was conducted online for final year BSc (Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics) students on 14-01-2022 at 1.40pm through in the online mode using google meet. In this tutorial, the focus was laid on identifying the safety symbols available on chemical bottles and different instruments that are used in chemistry laboratory along with the concept of MSDS will be introduced.

The objective was not only to inculcate a scientific attitude and research-mindedness but also to enhance student's interest in science and technology.


