
Report of Guest Lecture on "To know more about North East"

North East Desalities Association organized a Guest Lecture on "To know more about North East" on 30th June 2021 from 3:00 PM to 4.00 PM through G-meet (Online platform). The lecture was attended by 7 students from North East Region of St Francis De Sales College, Bangalore.


The event started by a welcome address by Tonmay. In her talk she emphasized the importance of the rich cultural heritage of the people of the North East region and the talent of its people, the prosperity of the eight States of the region was inevitable. She spoke on how the understanding of the cultural dimension could help bridge the difference and how language bonded the people and helped in the national integration process. The Northeast (NE) region of India is of great strategic significance. The Northeast region of India comprising of the states of Arunachal Pradesh, Assam, Meghalaya, Manipur, Tripura, Mizoram, Nagaland and Sikkim can be physio graphically categorized into the Eastern Himalayas, Northeast hills (Patkai-Naga Hills and Lushai Hills) and the Brahmaputra and Barak Valley plains. The states have distinct cultures and multiple ethnic groups and are a fine example of unity in diversity. The variety of ethnic groups, languages and religions reflect the multi-cultural character of the states. The region houses over 200 of the 635 tribal groups in the country, speaking a variety of Tibeto-Burman languages and dialects. States like, Arunachal Pradesh, Meghalaya, Mizoram and Nagaland are predominantly inhabited by tribals with a certain degree of diversity among the tribes. States like, Assam, Manipur, Tripura and Sikkim are inhabited by people of various religious denominations like, Hindus, Christians and Muslims and a combination of local tribes and communities. At the end she mentioned that there is a general lack of awareness about these states of North East India among young children, particularly those living in other parts of the country. 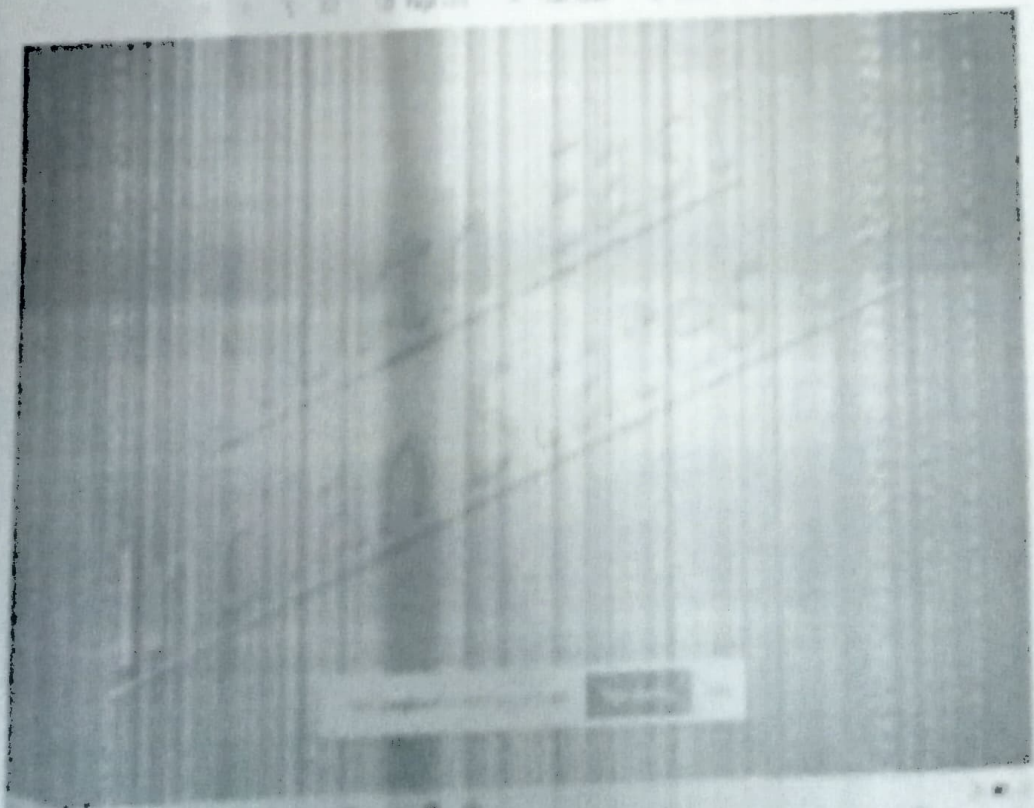
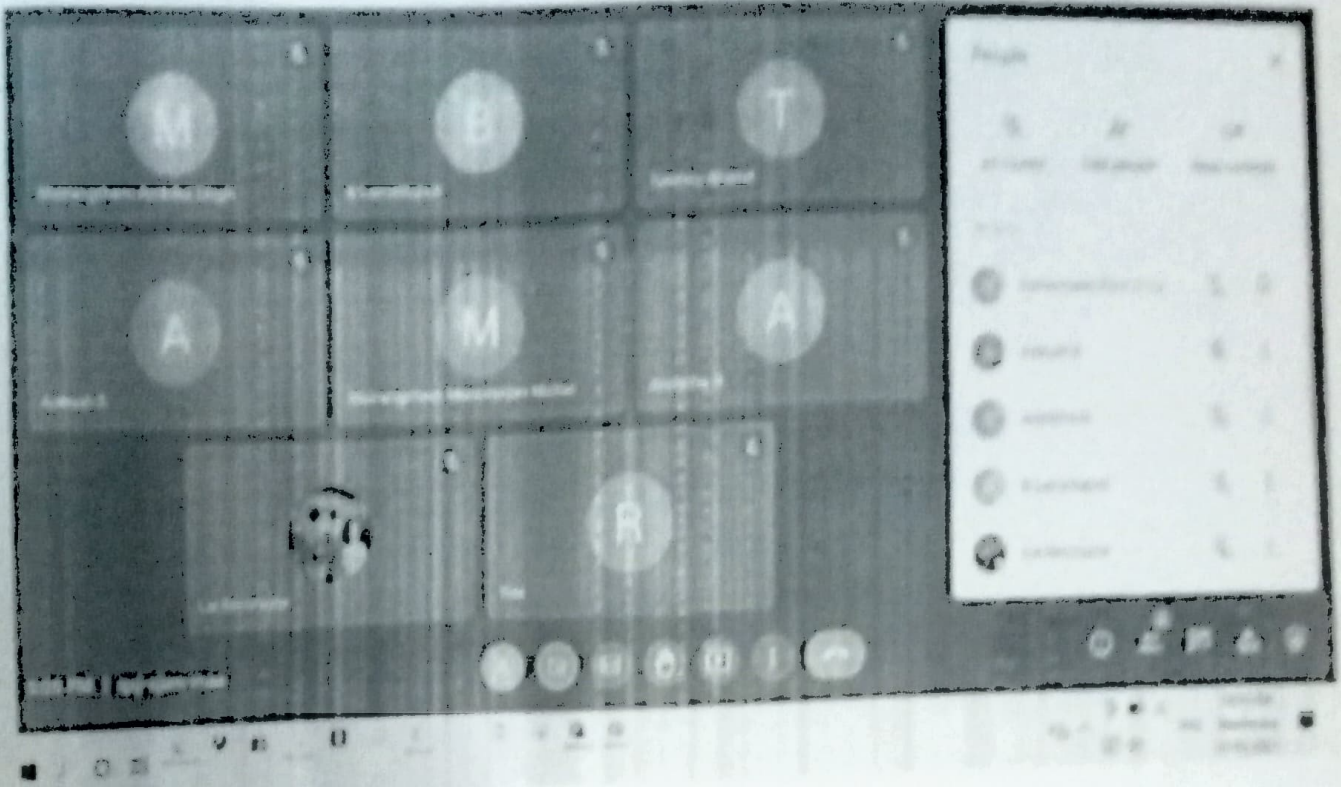

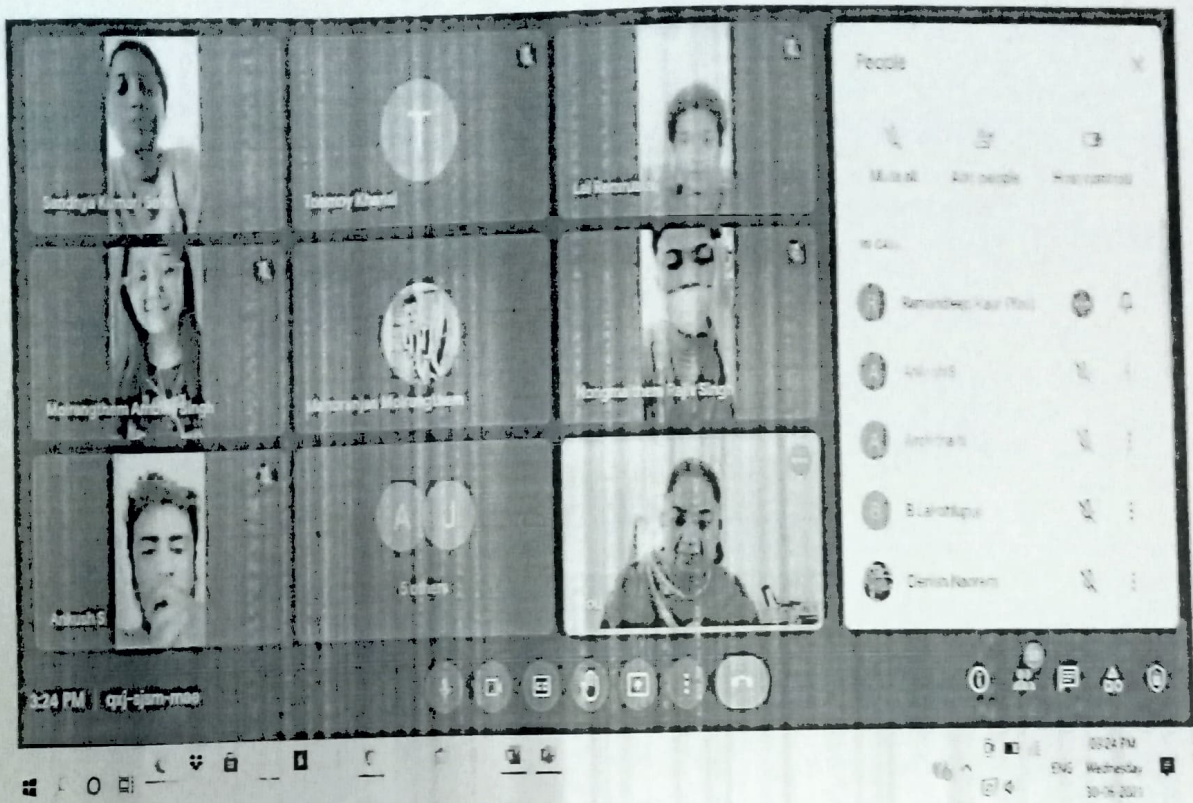
