## 1. Health care quiz on women's Health - 26-11-2021.

Desalite women empowerment cell had conducted a cancer awareness quiz on 26-11-2021 for all the faculty members to provide general awareness on cancer that usually affects women. Breast cancer is the most common cancer in women, it can occur at any age, but the risk goes up as you get older. Because of certain factors, some women may have a greater chance of having breast cancer than others. But every woman should know about the risks for breast cancer and what they can do to help lower their risk. The quiz questions were framed in such a way that each of the question had its explanation also, so that everyone would be able to understand the facts related to particular type of cancer. Almost 27 faculties took part in the quiz, e certificates were provided to all the faculties.
