Report:

21.10.2021:

As every year, staff induction and orientation programme were conducted with the tagline 'Starting on the right foot' which was held on 21st October 2021 at 11.45am hosted by Rev. Dr. Roy, Principal. Agenda of the programme was to elect new staff secretary, introducing new staff along with induction and orientation to staff members. Principal thanked and congratulated all the staff members, IQAC team, NAAC team, HODs, co-ordinators and the staff by acknowledging for their dedication and hard work. He also thanked the faculties who left the institution in their absence for their service rendered to the SFS institution to grow. Faculty joined for the present academic year were introduced by themselves to all. He thanked Prof. Sampath Kumar for his dedicated work as staff secretary in the previous academic year. Prof. Mangaiyarkarasi's name was proposed by the staff and she was elected as the staff secretary for this year.

Principal explained the need for the induction programme. He spoke about the history of the college and introduced the Management to all. ACs and HoDs were introduced in his presentation. Profile of a true Fransalian teacher was explained in detail. Extracts from service

rules, especially related to leave policy was explained. Staff members were oriented about

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what is expected from every SFS faculty. Staff members were oriented about the hierarchy followed in the institution. Leave rules as per service register was explained in detail. In the absence of principal and vice principal, the ACs are authorized to approve leave and take few minor decisions. Principal informed about the importance of maintaining proper attendance and other records. Further, he informed about the college policy, enrolment in PhD and actively engaging in research publications and various others duties and responsibilities were explained. Father also clarified that all the rules can be amended by the management on the basis of revision of rules and it stands unquestionable. The staff members were informed to use innovative teaching methodologies and not to restrict to 'Chalk and Talk' method. The Staff were informed that the first week of the academic year is set aside for the planning of the academic year. He mentioned that the hand book of the college would be kept ready and given to the staff shortly. Class coordinators were informed about their roles and responsibilities and were requested to give personal attention to every student. All were asked to wear ID card in the campus. He mentioned that the printing facility which was previously available in admin office has now been shifted to digital library. With all the orientation the session was concluded by 1.20PM.

22.10.2021:

On Day - 2, October 22nd, 2021 the orientation program on OBE was conducted for all the UG faculties and the session was conducted by OBE Committee members. OBE plays a major role in planning and implementing curriculum. Entire education system is dependent on Outcome Based Education. St Francis de Sales College has a detailed structure for execution of OBE. The committee members are trained to give training to faculty in the campus and also implement OBE. Faculty were divided according to three major streams. The training program was held in three different classrooms. The members gave a detailed explanation about OBE, bloom's taxonomy, PO, PSO and CO mapping. Members also showed mapping in the software.

Training began by introducing OBE and its objectives. POs were already given, which is common for the entire campus across all streams. PSOs were prepared by respective departments. COs had to be prepared for each subject in each stream. Subject faculty had to prepare COs for their subjects. Members of OBE explained the mapping system and structure. PO-CO attainment can be measured through calculations, members of the team explained the calculations too. Attainment in software was also explained with example. All the doubts raised by faculty were addressed and clarified. It was a very informative session.

23.10.2021:

Every year before the commencement of the Academic year, IQAC in collaboration with Faculty Enrichment Program Conducts an FDP. Induction Program for the faculty members for the academic year 2021-2022 was conducted in the closed Auditorium. Resource person Mr. Manoviraj, holds a Master's degree in Economics from Symbiosis School of Economics, Pune and has completed a PG in Development Leadership from Indian Schools of development management, Noida. He impacted the lives of 500 students with inclusive and quality education. He has been working with various universities, schools, CSR Foundations, State Government and central ministries to enhance Skills and employability of many students. He gave the vast description about the IBM skills build for job seekers, which enhances the new skill building platform for students and also the faculty. It was instructed to all the faculty about the available courses and the steps for logging in. He explained that IBM Skills build learning which has several tools to help the candidates find the right course and added that the career and learning insights assessments help the candidate's careers or job roles where they can shine better. He explained in details the three major skills which are Job Skills, Career Skills and Professional Skill. Number of courses come under these three major skills. Assessments in Skills build help us to give the insight into our potential and then using a science, non-biased approach which can be matched with our innate capabilities to learning pathways and careers to help you get started learning. He gave a clear picture about the assessment and the time taken for the courses. He gave a description of Learning Insights Assessment and Career Insights Assessment. He described the difference between the two insights assessment stating that candidate can receive a report with insight into the unique capabilities and potential. He explained the students and faculty members can have the opportunity to earn IBM skills build digital badge representing the capabilities which demonstrated the assessment. He explained the option of My Inner Genius which is in skills build. It will help the candidates to identify which types of careers best fit the interests and preferences and also understand job related interests and preferences. He mentioned specifically about the career options which is the topmost skills students like to attain and students can identify the unique set of skills, abilities and personality traits regardless of education, background or experience.
