#### Report:

Students of 3rd semester M.A. in Economics of S.F.S. College, visited Pruthvi Foundation, which is a NGO organization, doing social services in the field of handicap and blinds, and shelters to orphanage and rural education. The program focused to know the importance on social inclusive of suppressed citizens due to physically challenged. Blood donation drive was conducted with association with the foundation. Our students and faculty members donated blood as symbolic part to serve society. Our students volunteers and gave awareness and importance and blood donation. Students mobilized blood camp in and around the Chandapura and initiated many local people to donate blood. As a part of the outreach programme our students interacted with destitute, orphans, senior citizens and blind students who are pursuing education in various schools and colleges. In the afternoon session our students organized quiz program, singing competition, dance event at the venue to entertain them. During the stay in the orphanage centre, it was an experiential learning to the students, at the centre they provided us meals and snacks to the students, and there was interactive session held with the founder director of the organization, Ms. Bhannumathi, Philanthropist, she narrated her life experiences and struggles faced, she motivated the students to take part in various NGO events conducted. Students were given ample opportunities to interact with the members of the foundation.



