



Scholarship Policy

St. Francis de Sales College was established primarily to support and educate the needy students from the rural background. With that motto, the college has established a Scholarship Cell for the students which will financially support them to graduate and live a better life.

Policy Statement:

St. Francis de Sales College will provide scholarships to the deserving students under various scholarships provided by the management to motivate and encourage them.

1. The management of St. Francis de Sales College will be in-charge of the Scholarship Policy.
2. Any changes in the policy have to be approved by the Governing Council and the same body will be in charge of the approval of new scholarships provided to the students.
3. The Principal will be the approving authority for every scholarship provided.
4. A Scholarship Cell will be in-charge of the selection and for the dispersal of the scholarship by the management.
5. The Administrative Office will be in-charge of the government Scholarships provided to the students.
6. The selection of scholarship awards will be based on the required criteria for the scholarship provided.
7. The scholarships will be provided only to the students of St. Francis de Sales College, Bangalore.

List of Scholarships:

1. Learn at SFS Scholarship

Eligibility Criteria: Scholarship will be given to the financially weaker students who seek admission from the College to SFS Degree College.

Amount of support: Rs. 1500

2. Meritorious Scholarship

Eligibility Criteria: Scholarship will be given to the students who procure university ranks.

Amount of support: Rs. 2000.

3. Proficiency Scholarship

Eligibility Criteria: The Proficiency Scholarship will be awarded to the Batch toppers for every semester of the academic year.

Amount of support: Rs. 1000

4. SSA Scholarship

Eligibility Criteria: The Scholarship will be awarded to the financially weaker students and the amount will be decided by the management based on the need of the student who applies for the same.

5. MSFS Scholarship

Eligibility criteria: Christian minority students who excel in their academics, co-curricular and provide service to the society.

Amount of support: Rs. 2000

6. International Students Scholarship

Eligibility Criteria: The scholarship will be awarded to International students who secure above 50% in Class XII and apply for the scholarship.

Amount: It will vary depending on the sponsoring agency.

7. Fr. Raison Memorial Scholarship

Eligibility Criteria: This scholarship will be awarded to the topper who resides in the college hostel.

Amount of support: Rs. 10000

8. Desalite Aptitude Test Scholarship

Eligibility Criteria: This scholarship will be provided to the top-ranked students (Department-wise) of the scholarship test that is conducted for the first Year students at the beginning of the academic year.

Amount of support: Rs. 1500.

9. Centum Scholarship

Eligibility Criteria: The scholarship will be provided to students who secure centum in their respective subjects in the university exams.

Amount of Support: Rs. 1000.

10. Rising Star Scholarship

Eligibility: The scholarship will be provided to students who excel in co-curricular and extra-curricular activities in an academic year.

Amount of Support: Rs. 1000.

11. Girl Child Scholarship

Eligibility Criteria: The scholarship is given to deserving students, especially from the financially weaker background and who shows potential for excellence.

Amount of Support: Rs. 2000

12. Endowments

- a. Marina Rose Endowment - The endowment award of Rs. 2000 will be given to the overall batch topper across the disciplines.
- b. Papamma Endowment - The endowment award of Rs.2000 will be given for the batch toppers from B.Com and BBA.

- c. Chenga Reddy Endowment - The endowment award of Rs.2000 will be given for the batch toppers from BA, BCA and B.SC Programmes

13. Fr. Peter Mermier Scholarship

Scholarship awarded to students through outside agencies.

If any question arises relating to the interpretation of this Policy, it shall be referred to the MANAGEMENT whose decision shall be final.
