St. Francis de Sales College is managed by the Missionaries of St. Francis de Sales (MSFS) of the South West India Province, who firmly believe that *'the education of the heart is the heart of education'* as propounded by its founder, Fr. Peter Marie Mermier. The MSFS Fathers have nearly two centuries of experience and expertise in imparting quality higher education in every continent of the world. The Fathers are deeply committed to forming the 'future world citizens' through over 200 educational institutions in India.

The College is named after St. Francis de Sales, the patron of the Missionaries of St. Francis de Sales. St. Francis de Sales College is a minority institution with a secular outlook. St. Francis de Sales College came into existence in June 2004 with the motto: Excellence, Transformation and Efficiency. The College is affiliated to Bangalore University. The College was granted "A" grade by the NAAC team for its excellent educational track record as well as infrastructure in May 2015. In the year 2016-17, the College received permanent affiliation to Bangalore University along with permission to start five postgraduate courses: MSc Psychology, MA English, MA Mass Communication and Journalism, MCom, and MCom-Finance and Accounts. In 2016-17, for the benefit of students and staff, the College signed a memorandum of understanding with Dayton University, Ohio, USA, for exchange programmes. On 7 December 2018, University Grants Commission, New Delhi has granted St Francis de Sales College recognition under section 2(f), & 12(B) of the UGC Act, 1956. The College is now eligible to get grants for all UGC schemes related to teachers & students and also research projects from sources other than UGC. Now with all these new programmes introduced, the College stands ready to become an autonomous college in the near future.

Department of Science

BSc (Bachelor of Science)



BSc is a three-year under graduate program under Bangalore University spanning over six semesters. It follows triple major system where in students study Computer Science, Mathematics and Electronics or Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics as major subjects. The three year programme paves way for taking up further postgraduate programmes in Computer Science, Mathematics or Electronics.

Course Duration: 3 years

Department of Commerce BCom (Bachelor of Commerce)



This course is presently of high demand as it offers a wide range of opportunities to the students. This course is expected to develop in students knowledge and skills required for achieving wisdom through excellence in the field of Commerce and Business.

Course Duration: 3 years

Eligibility: Pass in 10+2/Pre-University Course/equivalent course recognized by Bangalore University.



Department of Business Administration BBA (Bachelor of Business Administration)



This course aims to introduce business management to students, to impart knowledge that would mould them as pillars of strength in the industry or non-trading organizations or as complete executives. The syllabus provides an insight into the economic, social and legal environment in which today's business world operates.

BBA-Regular:

BBA-Aviation Management

The three years undergraduate programme in Aviation Management is one of the flagship programs of Bangalore University. This program focuses on areas like aviation industry, organisations of aviation sector, air traffic control, operations and management of airlines, planning and management of airports, tourism management, strategic management, personal management, marketing, project management etc.,

Eligibility: Pass in two years pre-university course (Science/ Commerce) equivalent course recognized by Bangalore University.

Course Duration: 3 years

Eligibility: Pass in 10+2/Pre-University Course/ equivalent course recognized by Bangalore University.





Department of Computer Science BCA (Bachelor of Computer Application)



The Department of Computer Science was established to meet the demand for qualified computer professionals. The programme is designed to cater to the ever changing needs and demands of the IT industry. The course opens wide vistas of system analysis, design and application life cycle management practices to the students.

Course Duration: 3 years

Eligibility: Pass in 10+2/Pre-University Course/ equivalent course recognized by Bangalore University.



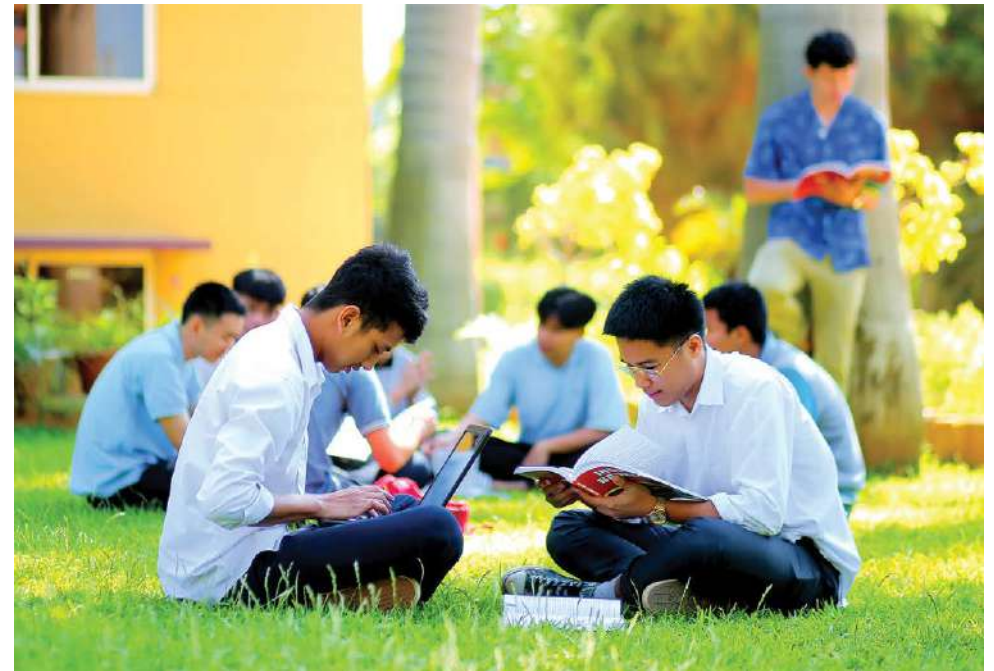




Department of Languages

POSTGRADUATE CENTRE



The College offers five Postgraduate Courses (MSc Psychology, MA English, MA Economics, MCom, and MCom-Finance and Accounts).

POSTGRADUATE COURSES

MCom

(Master of Commerce)

The Post-Graduate Degree in Commerce specializes in COMMERCE, ACCOUNTING, MANAGEMENT AND ECONOMICS and is a popular academic choice after humanities and science. It imparts knowledge on the inner workings of various financial institutions and business, trade, financial policies and the stock market as well as corporate finances and the general economy. Commerce as a specialization is much in demand to meet the ever-growing needs of the Indian economy, which is expanding exponentially at both national and international levels.

Course Duration: Two year full-time course

Eligibility: A Candidate who has passed 10+2+3 with BCom/BBA degree from Bangalore University or any other university recognized as equivalent are eligible for admission, provided they have obtained not less than 50% (45% for SC/ST/Category-1 candidates) marks in the aggregate in Commerce subjects.

MCom (F/A)

(Master of Commerce in Finance and Accounts)

18 A specialization in Finance & Accounting equips the student to gain



in-depth training, knowledge and skills in various aspects of business, accounting and finance. The course trains students to develop conceptual, management and analytical skills to evaluate changing financial market trends and use this to advise individuals and companies on fund investment and money management.

Course Duration: Two year full-time course

Eligibility: A Candidate who has passed 10+2+3 with BCom/BBA degree from Bangalore University or any other university recognized as equivalent is eligible for admission provided, they have obtained not less than 50% (45% for SC/ST/Category-1 candidates) marks in the aggregate in Commerce Subjects.

MA in English

(Master of Arts in English)

The curriculum of the postgraduate degree programme in English is comprised of poetry, prose, drama, fiction, non-fiction and critical theories in English.

Course Duration: Two year full-time course

Eligibility: A Candidate who has passed 10+2+3 with BA/ BSc or BCom degree from Bangalore University or any other university recognized as equivalent is eligible for admission, provided they have scored 55% marks in the concerned language in the degree course.

MSc Psychology

(Master of Science in Psychology)

This course will prepare students to work in various specialized and applied fields of psychology. The course provides students the required qualification and skills to work as Psychologists. The Masters program grounds students in theory, research and practice, providing them a systemic and holistic approach in understanding human behaviour.

Course Duration: Two year full-time course

Eligibility: Candidates with 40% marks in the aggregate of all the Optional Subjects in 3 years of Under graduation, with Psychology as one of the subjects and having scored aggregate 50% marks in the same.

M.Sc Mathematics

(Master of Science in Mathematics)

Duration: 2 year full-time (4 semesters)

Eligibility: B.A./B.Sc. with Honors in Mathematics or B.A./ B.Sc. (pass course) with Mathematics as one of the subjects having at least 50% marks in aggregate.

MBA

(Master of Business Administration)

Duration: 2 year full-time (4 semesters)

Eligibility: Candidates who have obtained a Bachelor's degree (10+2+3), Master's Degree from a recognized university in disciplines of Commerce, Management, Arts, Science, Engineering/Technology, or equivalent and have secured not less than 50% of Marks in aggregate (45% in case of SC/ST/Cat-1) including languages and an acceptable score in MAT/CAT/KMAT/CMAT/AIMA/PGCET. Admission will be based on the score secured in qualifying exam and personal interview.

Specialisation: Finance, Marketing and Human Resource Management

PG Diploma in Psychological Counselling

Course Duration: One year (2 semesters)

Eligibility: A graduate of Bangalore University or any other recognized university in India having studied in a regular course, in any of the following optional subject. Viz., Psychology/Sociology/Social Work/Home Science/ Human Resource Development (Management), or B.Ed., or a graduate in any discipline of Rehabilitation Science - A Doctor (from any medical faculty such as Allopathy/Ayurveda/Unani/Homeopathy), paramedical rehabilitation: Nurse, physiotherapist, Occupational therapist, speech therapist, audiologist with 50% marks in aggregate (including languages). The degree is awarded by the Bangalore University.

PG Diploma in Human Resource Management

Course Duration: One year (2 semesters)

Eligibility: Candidate with 40% marks in aggregate in Bachelor's/Master's Degree of any discipline of a recognized University are eligible of admission. Candidates studying in a regular course of study in any discipline are not eligible for admission. The degree is awarded by the Bangalore University.





MA Economics (Master of Arts in Economics)

This programme is offered to students who have successfully completed their Undergraduate programme with Economics as one of the subjects. The course work facilitates the students to take up careers in research, in the field of knowledge dissemination, corporate analytics, policy analysis, journalism in economics, competitive examinations etc.

Course Duration: Two year full-time course

Eligibility: Candidates who have secured 40% marks in the aggregate of all subjects and 50% marks in the cognate subject at the bachelors degree level.

 - ▶ Soon after the counselling/interview, the candidates selected shall be enrolled on payment of fee as per the fee structure. Admission is subject to the University's approval. No transfer from one discipline to any other is permitted.

Conditions pertaining to submission of documents

- ▶ At the time of admission, candidates must submit all the original documents, copies and other relevant documentation as well as a hardcopy of the completed application form.
- ▶ Students should ensure that they keep a photocopy of the documents for themselves before submitting the same to the admissions department.
- ▶ The original documents submitted will be returned to the student only at the end of the program.
- ▶ In order to take back these documents at the end of the program, a student must produce the documents acknowledgement receipt received during the time of admission.

Fee Regulations

- ▶ The fee shall be paid for the full year or for the first semester on the day of admission. Fee once paid, will not be refunded.
- ▶ The fee shall be remitted to the South Indian Bank branch office located within the campus.
- ▶ Students should retain the payment receipt for future reference.
- ▶ Students are expected to clear all their arrears including fine and breakage, damages etc. if any, to obtain their hall tickets for all the exams.
- ▶ Students shall obtain and produce a No Due Certificate (NDC) to obtain the hall ticket for all the exams.
- ▶ Students shall obtain a receipt for any fine/fees paid at the office on demand.

Physical Education

Well maintained playgrounds for various games like basketball, Volleyball, Cricket, Football, Softball, Baseball and Badminton are provided by the College with a firm belief that physical fitness leads to mental wellness. Along with these, provisions are arranged for indoor games like table tennis, chess, carrom board and badminton. The College organizes intra-college and inter-college tournaments and sports meets to give students ample opportunity to develop their talents and skills.

Research Cell (Seminars)

The Research is the backbone of Higher Education. The cell promotes a research oriented mind among faculty and students by steadfastly encouraging them for weekly seminars, presentations and guest lectures. Research cell looks into the publication of the books and journals of the Institute and attempts to cultivate an interest in research among students.

Counsellor

The Counsellor is a certified/licensed person with specific qualifications and skills to address the academic,





personal, social and career developmental needs of the students and the staff. The counsellor creates a safe learning environment to safeguard the rights of all members of the institution.

Anti-Ragging Cell & ICC

These bodies investigate into cases that are reported to the head of the institution and submits a report. They also helps the head of the institution to take decisions on the report and execute the same.

Women's Cell

The Women's cell was started with the aim of empowering and orienting women to recognize their potential and rights. It trains women to protect themselves, educates women their rights and duties, conducts various programmes and invites experts on various value-based topics to build a strong independent existence for them.

Career Guidance and Placement Cell

The Career Guidance and Placement Cell works as a facilitator between the student and the job industry. It regularly conducts career guidance classes for the students at regular intervals.

Certificate Courses/Add-on Courses

The college offers many certificate and add-on courses apt for each department. The placement officers and the coordinators keep a close watch on the certificate courses conducted by various departments.

Desalite Christian Association (DCA)

College Choir

Karnataka Civil Defence (KCD)

Civil Defence is a volunteer organization of people which fights to mitigate the effects of a disaster like an air-raid, earthquake, flood or civil disturbance on civilian life and to maintain the morale of the people at the time of crisis. KCD was started in our College in 2012.

National Service Scheme (NSS)
